Introduction

Tonight we're going to begin to see how the LORD raised up yet another JUDGE to deliver the CHILDREN OF ISRAEL from yet another OPPRESSION brought on yet again by their SIN!

We've been seeing in this book that the **HISTORICAL BACKGROUND** of this **TIME** was marked by a series of the same **CYCLE** occurring over and over again: Sin —> Suffering and/or Servitude—> Supplication—> Salvation—>Silence.

We saw as we left last time that after **DEBORAH** and **BARAK** delivered **ISRAEL**, the nation entered into a period of **SILENCE** or **REST** for 40 years. (Judges 5:31b)

Tonight we see **ISRAEL** make a mess of things again! When they finally cried out to the **LORD**, **HE** uses a young man by the name of **GIDEON** to deliver them the **OPPRESSION** and **SUFFERING** brought on by their **SIN**. We begin the same way as before...

- I. WE SEE ISRAEL'S SIN! (Judges 6:1a)
- II. WE SEE ISRAEL'S SUFFERING! (Judges 6:1b-6a)

 This particular time ISRAEL'S SUFFERING was for a period of seven years at the hand of the MIDIANITES. This was the LORD'S DIVINE JUDGMENT for ISRAEL having FORSAKEN HIM!

For seven years bands of MIDIANITES had swooped down on the farms of the ISRAELITES and pillaged and plundered them at will.

For **seven years** the defenseless **ISRAELITES** ran away in terror leaving their homes and possessions to the **MIDIANITES**.

III. WE SEE ISRAEL'S SUPPLICATION! (Judges 6:6b)
When ISRAEL finally had enough, they CRIED unto the LORD!
So, the LORD sent ISRAEL an unnamed PROPHET with a message telling them what their problem was! (Judges 6:7-10)

IV. WE SEE ISRAEL'S SALVATION! (And here is where we will plant ourselves for the rest of this message this evening and, LORD willing, the message the next week or so as well!

We See This Time That The LORD Raised Up And Called A Man By The Name Of GIDEON To Lead HIS People In Battle Against The MIDIANITES. (Judges 6:11-12)

The name "Gideon" means "he who cuts down or cuts to pieces; it can also mean a great warrior." We see that when the LORD appeared to him in verse 12, HE called GIDEON a MIGHTY MAN OF VALOUR. We are not told, but I envision here that GIDEON was quite possibly looking around to see who the LORD was talking to!)

Understand that the **LORD** knew beforehand *the mighty man of valour* that **GIDEON** would become for the **LORD** and **ISRAEL**!

I. WHEN THE ANGEL OF THE LORD FIRST CAME TO GIDEON HE WAS HIDING HIS WHEAT THRESHING ACTIVITY FROM THE MIDIANITES! (Judges 6:11-12a) The reason for that was because of what we see the MIDIANITES doing in verse 4. For GIDEON and his family to eat, he had to hide what he was doing or the MIDIANITES would confiscate his dad's wheat!

In the eyes of the world, **GIDEON** would probably have been one of the least likely candidates for a national **DELIVERER**!

After all, he was helping his dad FARM and was not a SOLDIER! What he was used to "cutting down" was wheat! We'll also see later, that early on, he demonstrated very little LEADERSHIP ABILITY.

This was, no doubt, one of the reasons why the **LORD** chose **GIDEON!** Because when the **VICTORY** was ultimately obtained, it would be obvious that the **LORD** was the **ONE WHO FOUGHT IT** and **WROUGHT IT** among **ISRAEL!**

Understand that the **LORD** is not necessarily looking for those who have all kinds of **SKILLS or ABILITIES** that **HE** can use! In reality, the only **ABILITY** the **LORD** wants in our life is our **AVAILABILITY to HEAR HIM** and **OBEY HIM!**

If we make ourselves **AVAILABLE** to **HIM**, **HE** both **CAN** and **WILL EQUIP US** and then **MOLD US** and **MAKE US** into the **SERVANTS HE WANTS US TO BE FOR HIS GLORY!**

- II. WE SEE THAT, IN SPITE OF GIDEON'S HIDING AND IN SPITE OF HIS DOUBTS ABOUT HIMSELF, THE LORD WAS WITH HIM AND CALLED HIM TO DELIVER ISRAEL! (Judges 6:12b-16)
- III. WE SEE THAT AT FIRST GIDEON'S FAITH WAS WEAK! (Judges 6:14-24)
 - A. GIDEON'S Weak Faith Is Shown In His Initial FOCUS On His Own LIMITATIONS And WEAKNESSES Rather Than On The LORD! (Vs 14-15)

Because **GIDEON** was focused on self instead of the **LORD**, he failed to see how the **LORD** could use him for anything at all!

Note how he freely confesses three things: (Vs 15)

1. He Confesses That He Was An Insignificant Man! That may have been true in some respects, but *verse 27* indicates that he had at least ten servants.

But even had he been a **significant** man in the eyes of man or in his own eyes, he would still be **insignificant** compared to the **LORD!** *Psalms 39:5*—"...verily every man at his best state is altogether vanity."

So, in reality, everyone who the **LORD** calls is truly **insignificant** no matter no matter how **significant** they or anyone else thinks they are! (*The Lord Jesus said in John 15:5– "...for without me ye can do nothing."*)

2 Corinthians 3:5—"Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;"

He Confesses That He Was An Insignificant Man...

- 2. He Confesses That He Was From A Poor And Insignificant Family!

 Again, he had at least ten servants (Vs 27) and his father owned an altar unto Baal that had a grove beside it (Vs 25).
- 3. He Confesses That He Was The Least In His Father's House! (Vs 15)
 We don't know if this was just his own perspective or if it was indeed a reality. But it doesn't really matter.
 (e.g. Both Joseph and David)
- B. The Call Of The LORD On GIDEON'S Life Trumped His Weak Faith! (Vs 14b, 16)

1 Corinthians 1:26–29–"26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: 27 But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; 28 And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: 29 That no flesh should glory in his presence."

So we see that the call of the **LORD** was on **GIDEON'S** life in spite of his **PERCEIVED INSIGNIFICANCE** and **INADEQUACIES.** And we will see how the **LORD** used him mightily at this very important time in **ISRAEL'S** history.

C. GIDEON'S Weak Faith Is Seen In His Interaction With The Angel Of The LORD! (Vs 17-24)

Before we move on, let's think about the FAITH of CHRIST'S DISCIPLES! It took GREAT FAITH to accomplish what we see in the early CHURCH! However, we read on more than one occasion, before the RESURRECTION of JESUS, that the DISCIPLES' FAITH was described as being "little" by the SAVIOUR! (JESUS said to them "O ye of little faith" Matthew 6:30; 8:26; 14:21; 16:8)

But just as GIDEON'S FAITH increased, so did theirs!

IV. WE SEE GIDEON'S FIRST ASSIGNMENT FROM THE LORD! (Judges 6:25-26)

We will get to the familiar story of **GIDEON'S** great victory over the **MIDIANITES** with his reduced army of 300 next week, **LORD** willing, but there was another battle that **GIDEON** had to fight first.

After all, the **MIDIANITES** were not the main problem here. They were an effect of the real problem. What good would it do to rid the land of the **MIDIANITES** if they didn't get rid of what brought the **MIDIANITES** to the land?

ISRAEL'S greatest problem was not **MIDIAN**; it was **BAAL!** Their **SPIRITUAL problem** was greater than their **PHYSICAL problem!** It was their **IDOLATRY** and **WORSHIP OF BAAL** that had caused the **LORD** to send the **MIDIANITES** to oppress them!

The **LORD** was not going to take away the **MIDIANITES** until they disposed of **BAAL**! **BAAL** would have to be renounced before **MIDIAN** could be driven out of the land!

So, the LORD put GIDEON to the test! HE instructed GIDEON to:

- 1) Tear down the altar of **BAAL** that his father had,
- 2) To cut down the **GROVE** beside it, and
- 3) To build an altar to the **LORD GOD** and sacrifice his father's seven year old bull using the wood he got from cutting down the **GROVE!**

Before **GIDEON** could be trusted to **DELIVER** his nation, he first had to **DELIVER** his family! Before he could do war with the **MIDIANITES**, he had to declare war on **BAAL!** First things first!

In order for **GIDEON** to do this he had to deal with his **FEARS**—The **FEAR** of his father and the **FEAR** of the men of his city!

V. WE SEE GIDEON OBEYED THE LORD, BUT HE DID SO AT NIGHT! (Vs 27)

He did it by night because he was afraid of both his kinfolk and the men in his city.

VI. WE SEE THE UPROAR BY THE MEN IN THE CITY FOR WHAT HAD BEEN DONE BY GIDEON! (Vs 28-30)

When it was discovered that **GIDEON** was the one who had torn down the altar of **BAAL** and cut down the **GROVE** beside it, the men of the city sought his life and wanted his father to bring his son out to them!

VII. WE SEE THAT GIDEON'S FATHER CAME TO HIS DEFENSE! (Vs 31)

Responding to the men of the city, **GIDEON'S** father actually came to his son's defense and argued that if **BAAL** were god he would not need them to plead for his son's life. **BAAL** could plead for his son's life himself.

GIDEON had acted with FAITH and OBEDIENCE at a time when most were afraid to live for the LORD! GIDEON'S FAITH was based on the WORD OF GOD!

GIDEON was then given another name by his father—"Jerubbaal", which means "let Baal plead." (Vs 32)

Conclusion
