Tom & Kathy McConnell have served as missionaries of Grace Community Church to the U.K since April 2003.

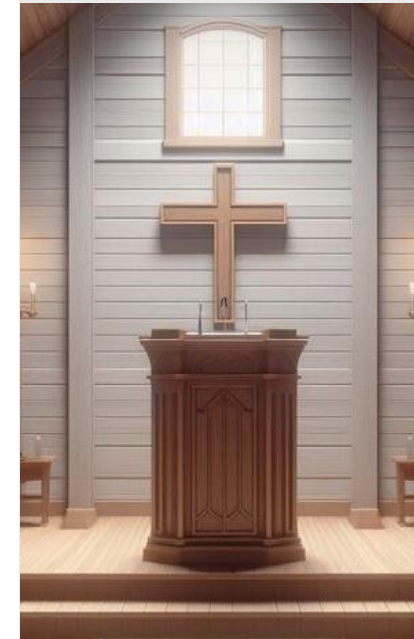

**"And He said, 'If you will give earnest heed to the voice of the Lord your God, and do what is right in His sight, and give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians; for I, the Lord, am your healer.'"**

Exodus 15:26

When the Lord redeemed the nation of Israel from Egypt, He did it with a powerful hand. His desire was that they would come to know Him. On countless occasions though, God tested Israel's commitment and faith to Him by their obedience to the Mosaic Covenant. Often, Israel would disobey God, yet compassionately, God would display one of His actions which further elucidated the significance of His name such as "Yahweh is healer." This means that God is the restorer of all things. He alone can restore all creation! **But God restores and heals only through His Son Jesus Christ.** When we were dead in our sins and trespasses, God by His grace and mercy, through His Spirit, and through the gospel of His Son, spiritually restored us to a new and right relationship with Him. However, this healing isn't over yet. **One day, when we see Christ our God, we will be fully and physically restored, receiving our glorified bodies, void of sin and corruption.** Now we know God partly as healer, but then, we will come to know Him fully as healer and restorer.
