HCQ11. But isn't God also merciful?

**HCQ12. According to God's righteous judgment
we deserve punishment
both now and in eternity:
how then can we escape this punishment
and return to God's favor?**

either by ourselves or by another.

HCQ13. Can we make this payment ourselves?
