"ENOCH WALKED WITH GOD"

(A shining light in the line of Seth) (Genesis 4:25-5:32)

INTRODUCTION: The Genealogy of Seth

In contrast to the corrupt line of Cain (4:17-24), God shows us that in the lineage of Seth (4:25-5:32) some people sought the Lord and lived for Him. *"Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the LORD" (Gen.4:26) "Enoch walked with God" (Gen.5:22) "Noah...shall comfort us" (Gen.5:29)*

Genesis 5 focuses particularly on one man. His name was Enoch. ***"Enoch walked with God" - So can you!**

I. The <u>MEANING</u> of Enoch's Walk With God (Gen. 5:22, 24)

II. The <u>TIME</u> of Enoch's Walk With God (Gen. 5:21-24; 6:5)

- A. Enoch walked with God "after" his son was born (v. 22)
- B. Enoch walked with God for 300 years (v. 23-24)
- C. Enoch walked with God in a wicked world (6:5)
- III. The <u>OCCUPATION</u> of Enoch's Walk With God (Jude 14-15) *Enoch walked with God and preached judgment
- IV. The <u>INCENTIVE</u> of Enoch's Walk With God (Heb. 11:5) *Enoch walked with God because He <u>believed</u> God

V. The <u>REWARDS</u> of Enoch's Walk With God (Heb. 11:5b; cp. Gen. 5:24)

- A. Enoch's walk with God gained him a <u>powerful testimony</u> (11:5b)
- B. Enoch's walk with God gained him <u>deliverance from death</u> (11:5; Gen. 5:24)
