

## THE KINSMAN-REDEEMER

Job foresaw Jesus Christ in His first advent as the Daysman—the one \_\_\_\_\_ between God and man  
Job also foresaw Christ in His Second Coming as the Redeemer who would bring about his \_\_\_\_\_  
In ancient times the redeemer was a close \_\_\_\_\_ who had responsibility to help in certain situations

### I. \_\_\_\_\_ : The Redeemer Redeemed His Kinsman

A. The OT Illustration: The Book of \_\_\_\_\_

Boaz married Ruth and \_\_\_\_\_ the estate of her dead husband as well as fathered a child in his line

B. The NT Reality: Jesus has redeemed the estate of our \_\_\_\_\_

1) 2 Corinthians 5:1-2

a) Jesus did not just buy back our “earthly tent” but a “building from God \_\_\_\_\_ in the heavens”

b) The story of Ruth illustrates redemption, but nothing in history illustrates what \_\_\_\_\_ did for us

2) Romans 8:23

a) We groan for the redemption of our bodies because we have the firstfruits of the \_\_\_\_\_

b) Believers experience “the firstfruits” when the \_\_\_\_\_ of God seems to overshadow us

c) These experiences are only a glimmer of what it shall be like to have a \_\_\_\_\_ body

3) Matthew 20:28

The “ransom”—the price to redeem our bodies was the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ given in death upon the cross

### II. \_\_\_\_\_ : The Redeemer Rescued His Kinsman

A. The OT Illustration: Abraham and \_\_\_\_\_ *Genesis 14*

1) In a civil war the king of Sodom was defeated and the northern kings took Lot & his family \_\_\_\_\_

2) Abraham and the men of his house attacked these kings and \_\_\_\_\_ all that had been captured

B. The NT Reality: Jesus has rescued us from captivity to \_\_\_\_\_ *Romans 6*

1) By virtue of our union with Christ in His death and resurrection we have been \_\_\_\_\_ from sin

2) According to Romans 6:17 we used to be “\_\_\_\_\_ of sin”—captives of the kingdom of darkness

3) But verse 18 teaches that by union with Christ we have been set from sin and now serve \_\_\_\_\_

4) Once we were not able not to sin, but since Christ rescued us, we are able \_\_\_\_\_

### III. \_\_\_\_\_ : The Redeemer Avenged His Kinsman

A. The OT Illustration: Abner and Joab *2 Samuel 2-3*

1) While fleeing from battle, Abner killed Asahel, even though he feared Asahel’s brother, \_\_\_\_\_

2) Though Abner made a treaty with David, Joab called him back and killed him in the \_\_\_\_\_ of Hebron

B. The NT Reality: Jesus has avenged His kinsmen on their enemy, \_\_\_\_\_ *1 Corinthian 15:54-57*

1) The context in 1 Corinthians 15 speaks of the bodily resurrection of the believer at Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_

2) At that time, Death will be “swallowed up in victory”; it will be the “\_\_\_\_\_ of Death” for believers

CONC: Jesus has undertaken these 3 responsibilities because He is our \_\_\_\_\_ --100% human
