Because He Lives

John 19:32-20:31

- 1. John recorded proofs of the resurrection
 - a. John witnessed and certified the death of Jesus, refuting the theory that Jesus never died, but <u>resuscitated</u> in the tomb.
 - b. The theory that the body of Jesus was stolen is refuted by the heavy stone that secured the tomb, and by the <u>graveclothes</u> left behind.
 - c. The theory that the resurrection was an elaborate hoax is doubtful because the Bible identifies <u>women</u> as main witnesses.
 - d. The disciples' instinct for self-preservation dictated that they would not <u>risk</u> their <u>lives</u> to testify of Jesus' resurrection unless they had seen him.
 - e. An eyewitness was the most reliable legal testimony during New Testament times. Over <u>500</u> eyewitnesses testified they had seen the risen Lord.
- 2. John told us why he recorded the proofs
 - a. "That you may <u>believe</u> that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God"
 - b. "That by believing you may have <u>life</u> in his name"
