What the Bible says concerning how a Christian can live in this world of trouble and have peace.

How do Christians live in a troubled world?

- John 16:33 These things I have **spoken** unto you, that in me ye might have **peace**. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have **overcome** the world.
 - God's Word
 - God's Peace
 - God's Victory

God's Word

- These things I have "spoken" unto you......
 - Greek word "laleō"
 - to speak, to utter a voice,
 - use words to declare one's mind or one's thoughts.
- John 14, 15, & 16
- John 1:1 Word
 - Greek work "logos"
 - a word, uttered by a living voice, embodies a conception or idea
 - what someone has said
 - discourse
 - doctrine, teaching
 - anything reported in speech; a narration, narrative
 - Acts 8:14 "Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the <u>word of God</u>, they sent unto them Peter and James.

God's Word

- Genesis 1: 3,6,9,11,14,20,24,26,28,29 God
 "speaks" creation into existence.
 - Genesis 2:7, God "speaks" of man's creation (1:26), then performs (formed) the act of creation.
 - This is what Isaiah spoke of in Is 64:8 when he talked of the potter.
- ■John 17: 9, 20
- Romans 15:4
- ■1 John 2:1-6

God's Peace

- "that in me, ye might have peace".
 - Greek work "eirēnē"
 - a state of national tranquility
 - peace between individuals, i.e. harmony, concord
 - security, safety, prosperity, felicity, (because peace and harmony make and keep things safe and prosperous)
 - of Christianity, the tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot, of whatsoever sort that is
- Peace is not the absence of war or conflict.
 - 2 Timothy 3:12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

God's Peace

- Philippians 4:6-12
- 1 Timothy 6:6-10
 - "Content" in Phil 4:11 and "Contentment" in 1 Tim 6:6 come from similar Greek words (autarkeia and autarkes) and mean to have sufficient necessities and no need of external support. Whereas "content" in 1 Tim 6:8 comes from the Greek word arkeo, and means to be strong, sufficient, satisfied.
- Ephesians 2:13-17
- Romans 5:1-4
- Romans 14:16-19
- The key to God's peace is to be "in him". Outside of relationship with God, there is no true peace.
 - Know God, Know Peace!
 - No God, No Peace!

God's Victory

- "I have **overcome** the world."
 - Greek word nikaō
 - to conquer
 - to carry off the victory, come off victorious
 - of Christ, victorious over all His foes
 - of Christians, that hold fast their faith even unto death against the power of their foes, and temptations and persecutions
 - From the root nike (victory) and related to nikos (to utterly vanquish)
- Romans 8:31-37
- Revelations 22:12-14

God's Victory

- ■Isaiah 25:8-9
- Matthew 12:20-21
- **■**1 Corinthians 15:54-58
- ■1 John 5:4-5
