FAITH IN JESUS, THE SAVIOR

- I. The Savior.
 - A. "Jesus" is the personal name of the Son of God in our flesh.
 - 1. This name is significant because God gave it to His Son (Matt. 1:21; Luke 1:31).
 - 2. His personal name declares Who and what He is (His mission), i.e., Savior: "Jehovah salvation."
 - B. The angel explained the name: Jehovah saves from sin (Matt. 1:21).
 - 1. Sins are all our violations of God's will, to which we add daily to the mountain of our sin and guilt.
 - 2. Jehovah, the Self-existent One, performs the work of saving.
 - C. Jesus is Savior of "His people" from "their" sins.
- I. Jesus is the only true Savior because He actually saves from sin.
- A. Sin earns guilt, which deserves the punishment of death (God's anger).
 - This is the cause of all the misery in this world, social, economic, and spiritual.
 - 2. Jesus saves from the punishment of sin, not first from sin's results (though He will one day).
- B. He is not just a Savior, but THE Savior, the only One.
- C. Jesus actually and fully saved; He did not merely create the possibility for salvation.
 - He is Savior for us, actually changing our guilt into innocency, removing every liability to be punished.
 - 2. He is Savior in us by applying that which He bought to us
- III. Jesus is the perfect Savior completely saving us to the uttermost so there is nothing left to be done.
 - A. Jesus did everything necessary for salvation so nothing has to be added to His complete and perfect work.
 - B. Because Jesus is the true Savior, there is no need for saints, Mary, or good works.
 - 1. He is not just a Savior, but He is THE Savior, the only One.
 - 2. He is THE way, and no one comes to the Father but by Him (John 14:6).
 - C. Do you believe in this perfect Savior who is revealed in this Name?
