THE DUTIES REQUIRED IN THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT ARE, TRUTH, FAITHFULNESS, AND JUSTICE IN CONTRACTS AND COMMERCE BETWEEN MAN AND MAN;<sup>A</sup> RENDERING TO EVERYONE HIS DUE;<sup>B</sup> RESTITUTION OF GOODS UNLAWFULLY DETAINED FROM THE RIGHT OWNERS THEREOF;<sup>C</sup> GIVING AND LENDING FREELY, ACCORDING TO OUR ABILITIES, AND THE NECESSITIES OF OTHERS;<sup>D</sup> MODERATION OF OUR JUDGMENTS, WILLS, AND AFFECTIONS CONCERNING WORLDLY GOODS;<sup>E</sup> A PROVIDENT CARE AND STUDY TO GET,<sup>F</sup> KEEP, USE, AND DISPOSE THESE THINGS WHICH ARE NECESSARY AND CONVENIENT FOR THE SUSTENTATION OF OUR NATURE, AND SUITABLE TO OUR CONDITION;<sup>G</sup> A LAWFUL CALLING,<sup>H</sup> AND DILIGENCE IN IT;<sup>I</sup> FRUGALITY;<sup>J</sup> AVOIDING UNNECESSARY LAW—SUITS,<sup>K</sup> AND SURETISHIP, OR OTHER LIKE ENGAGEMENTS;<sup>L</sup> AND AN ENDEAVOUR, BY ALL JUST AND LAWFUL MEANS, TO PROCURE, PRESERVE, AND FURTHER THE WEALTH AND OUTWARD ESTATE OF OTHERS, AS WELL AS OUR OWN.<sup>M</sup>
