We have been studying the attributes of God.

#### What is God like?

God has many amazing attributes.

## God is...

• Creator • Truth • Eternal • Self-existent • Gracious He is the Great I AM • Wise • Righteous • Sovereign • Holy • Good, ... • Omnipotent - God is Present - Unchanging - God is Faithful.

Today we are looking at:

God's **omniscience**!

Omni = all

Science = knowledge

God has **ALL KNOWLEDGE**. He knows everything.

He knows everything about Santa Rosa Bible Church. He knows everything about what President Biden is doing in Washington DC. He knows everything about everything that is going on in the world.

And, he knows everything about you!

He knows what you ate for breakfast. He knows what's under your bed at home. He knows how many hairs are on your head.

He knows everything about you.

We're going to look at Psalm 139:1-6.

## **Psalm 139:1**

<sup>1</sup> You have searched me, LORD, and you know me.

God, **not only** do you know everything about me, <u>but</u> you **WANT** to <u>know</u> everything about me. You want to know me.

You have searched me.

God has **DONE HIS RESEARCH** on you. He's <u>searched</u> out <u>everything</u> about you. Because he <u>loves you</u> and he <u>wants</u> to <u>know you</u>.

Have you ever made a **new friend?** And you're so <u>excited</u> to get to know your friend. You want to <u>talk</u> and <u>play</u> with your friend. You want to go see their <u>house</u>, and see their <u>room</u>. You want to find out what they <u>like to do</u>. You want to know <u>everything</u> about your friend.

That's how God feels about you. He really wants to know you.

So he has <u>searched</u> out everything there is to know about you.

## God, You know everything about me.

<sup>2</sup> You know when I sit and when I rise;

God knows that you're sitting down right now. He knows when you will get up.

He's **paying attention** to you.

Sometimes I hear kids complain: "She is ignoring me."

- She's **NOT** listening.
- She's not looking at me.
- She's not paying attention.

**But God** is <u>not</u> like that. He is <u>paying close attention</u> to you.

He <u>always knows</u> what you're <u>doing</u>.

And **beyond that**, He always knows what you're thinking.

<sup>2</sup> You know when I sit and when I rise;

you perceive my thoughts from afar.

Sometimes you get in <u>trouble</u>, and it was **NOT** really <u>your fault</u>.

You think, "It was an accident. I didn't mean to do that."

God knows. He knows your thoughts. [BRAIN]

Sometimes **NO ONE ELSE KNOWS** that you're <u>sad</u>. Or that you're <u>lonely</u>. **But God** <u>knows</u>. And, he <u>cares</u>.

He knows **YOUR THOUGHTS** <u>now</u> and he knows them from <u>afar</u>.

• **<u>Right Now</u>**: No matter where you <u>go</u> on earth. No matter how far you <u>travel</u>. ... He knows what you're thinking.

- There are thoughts in the <u>back of your mind</u> that you <u>forgot</u> about. There in your brain somewhere. He knows about those too.
- **In the Past**: He knows what you were thinking <u>yesterday</u>. Or <u>last year</u>. Or even years ago when you were a <u>baby</u>. You were like, "Wow, this <u>banana</u> is really good!" You <u>couldn't talk</u> yet, but you were thinking it. And, He knows those thoughts.
- Even the earliest thoughts that went through our mind <u>seconds</u> and <u>minutes</u> after we were <u>born</u>. Even thoughts that you have completely forgotten about.
- <u>In the Future</u>: He knows what you're going to think about <u>tomorrow</u>. He knows what you will think about far into the <u>future</u>... when your <u>soccer</u> team wins. When you <u>graduate</u> from high school. When you get <u>married</u>. When you have your own <u>kids</u> and when you're <u>really OLD</u> and you have your own <u>grandkids</u>. He knows what you're going to be thinking about even then.
  - When you come to the end of your life: When you're in the hospital and you're about to die. He'll be there with you... And he already knows what you will be thinking on that day.

He knows our thoughts. He knows them all.

And, he knows what we are doing as we think these thoughts.

<sup>3</sup> You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.

Our God knows when we <u>lie down</u> to <u>sleep</u> and when we rise to face the day. He knows when we are <u>working</u> on a project. He knows when we take a <u>nap</u>.

And, he knows what you're going to say before you say it.

<sup>4</sup> Before a word is on my tongue you, LORD, know it completely.

You haven't even thought about what you're going to say, but God already knows.

He knows when you're <u>tempted</u> to say <u>mean words</u> to your brother or sister. Or, when you are being really <u>nice</u>, and you're thinking of <u>kind words</u> that you can say to them.

- Good job
- I love you
- You are so special to me

He knows. God is omniscient.

You have **NEVER** <u>spoken</u> a word that <u>God didn't know before</u> you said it. Maybe you were speaking <u>off the cuff</u>. <u>Spontaneously</u>. Just saying whatever <u>popped</u> into your head.

The <u>words come out</u> and you think, "Oh no. I **shouldn't** have <u>said</u> that." Your words are a <u>surprise</u> even to you. But they are <u>not to God</u>.

Some have said of a dear friend: "She knows me better than I know myself."

That is <u>never more true</u> than when referring to <u>God</u>. He knows you THAT well!

There's something in us that **wants to be known**. Wants to be <u>cared</u> about. Wants to be understood.

I never realized how <u>important</u> my <u>family</u> was until I went <u>off to college</u>. It was so lonely being in a place where no one knew me. Where I had no friends.

I remember walking across campus pretending like I had somewhere to go.

When I first got to college my freshman year, I felt like my **PAST HAD BEEN <u>ERASED</u>**. No one knew anything about me. I was <u>anonymous</u>. And, there was a <u>drive</u> in me to want to <u>be known</u>.

During the first week, I was put in a <u>small group</u>. In my group, We learned each other's names. We shared <u>details</u> about our lives. These people in my group started to know me. And, I <u>felt close</u> to that group. And, I wanted to spend <u>more time</u> with them. I wanted to be with the people who knew me.

There's something in us that <u>wants to be known</u>. That wants people to <u>check up</u> on us. To <u>care</u> about us. To <u>worry</u> about us. To know us.

And, how wonderful it is that <u>our God knows us</u>. He knows every <u>detail</u> of our lives...<u>past</u>, <u>present</u> and <u>future</u>. He knows every <u>thought</u> that ever <u>entered</u> our mind or ever <u>will enter</u> our mind.

There's a **joy** in that. **BUT** there's also a **fear**.

We fear that if people know us too well, they might **NOT like us**. If you knew everything about me, you might <u>not like me</u>.

And, we wonder. **God**, you have <u>seen it all</u>. You know everything about me. Do you still like me?

Will you still be my friend? Or, will you ditch me?

But quite the <u>opposite</u> is <u>true</u>. He does **not** move <u>away</u>, but draws <u>near</u>.

<sup>5</sup> You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me.

**HEM** is used in sowing. It makes me think about laying on a big snugly quilt where God puts material over me and sows me in tight so I am snuggly and warm with his closeness.

The **Net Bible** translates this: You <u>squeeze me</u> in.

**God** is all up in my space.

Years ago we had a **neighbor** who was always **spying on us**. She peaked through the fence. She had a two story house that could <u>see</u> the entirety of our <u>backyard</u>. If we looked out our <u>window</u>, it was a common occurrence to <u>see her face</u> looking back. We had the **feeling that she knew everything** that was going on at our house.

In reality, I'm sure she <u>didn't</u> quite know everything. But <u>God does</u>. He knows everything.

It's astounding. David says...

<sup>6</sup> Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

How does God know all of that? That's a lot of information!

Have you heard about DNA? – That's the <u>computer code</u> in your body that <u>determines</u> who <u>you are</u>...what you <u>look</u> like, how <u>tall</u> you'll be, etc.

The DNA for **JUST YOU** would fill the pages of 200 1,000-page New York City telephone books.

- It would take a person typing 60 words per minute, eight hours a day, around 50 years to type the human genome.
- If all <u>three billion</u> letters in your genome, your DNA, were stacked <u>one millimeter</u> apart, they would reach a height <u>7,000 times</u> the height of the <u>Empire State Building</u>.
- If all the DNA in your body was put end to end, it would reach to the sun and back over 600 times.

And that's just for YOU. Just for 1 person.

**God knows** the <u>DNA</u> and all the intimate <u>details</u> about <u>every person on earth</u>.

 And not just the people that live <u>today</u>, but every person that ever lived in the <u>history</u> of the world.  And, he knows all these <u>details</u> about every person who <u>will ever live</u> in the future ... <u>until</u> the end of the world.

**David** says: This is <u>mind-blowing</u>. It's <u>too wonderful</u> for me. It's <u>too lofty</u> for me to attain simply the <u>amount</u> of <u>knowledge</u> housed in the <u>mind</u> of <u>God</u>.

But there's **ANOTHER THING** that's <u>too wonderful</u> for David. He <u>can't understand</u> how God <u>knowing everything</u> he does about him <u>still loves him</u>.

You ever wonder... God you know everything about me. Do you still love me?

Do you ever get tired of me?

One of our greatest <u>fears</u> is that people will get to <u>know us</u> and then **NOT** <u>love us</u>. That they <u>won't like us</u>. They won't <u>want</u> to be our <u>friend</u>.

**I** have done a <u>lot of bad</u> things. And, I <u>wonder</u> sometimes... How could <u>God love me</u>?

But <u>he does!</u> He loved me so much that he <u>sent</u> <u>Jesus to die</u> on the <u>cross</u> so that all of my sins could be <u>forgiven</u>. He loves me that much!

# This is amazing!!!

**God**, you know it all. And, you still love me. This is too wonderful for me! It sounds too good to be true.

God, I don't know what to say. I am so happy.

I can't believe that you <u>love</u> me, and you <u>think</u> about me all the time.

# Verse 17

<sup>17</sup> How precious to me are your thoughts, O God!

How vast is the sum of them!

<sup>18</sup> If I would count them, they are more than the sand.

Do you know how much sand there is on earth?

<u>Scientists</u> have calculated an <u>estimate</u> of <mark>7 quintillion</mark>, five hundred quadrillion grains of sand. That's a 7, then a 5, and then 17 zero's.

That's how much God thinks about you. That's how many thoughts he has about you.

God is omniscient. He knows everything.

He <u>thinks</u> about <u>you</u> **all the time**.

And he loves you very much!
