**"I am the resurrection and the life."**

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ (2 Corinthians 5:17). With salvation comes a complete change in our outlook.
- B. \_\_\_\_\_. Not only does he save us from sin He keeps us from falling away from Him (1 Peter 1:3-5; Jude 24; 2 Tim. 1:12).

II. THE \_\_\_\_\_

**"He that believeth in me."**—Man must believe in his heart (Rom. 10:9, 10). When he does this, he will practice the teachings of Christ.

- A. Practice by having \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb. 11:1). Though we can't see God we must believe in Him (Heb. 11:6). Increase your faith (Rom. 10:17).
- B. Practice by being \_\_\_\_\_. The Bible warns us to be faithful until death (Rev. 2:10).
- C. Practice by \_\_\_\_\_. We must have fellowship with the Lord as well as with one another (1 John 1:6-7).

III. THE \_\_\_\_\_

**"Though he were dead, yet shall he live."**

- A. A life of \_\_\_\_\_ (Ps. 16:11). Happiness can be achieved only by being satisfied. Man cannot be satisfied until he knows Christ.
- B. A life of \_\_\_\_\_ (Rom. 6:23). Though the wages of sin is death, God's gift is eternal life. Death is not the end to the Christian—it's the start of eternal life.

IV. THE \_\_\_\_\_

**"And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die."**

- A. The \_\_\_\_\_ (Isa. 53:5). Christ's death brought life to mankind.
- B. The \_\_\_\_\_ (John 5:24). By believing in Christ we pass from death to life. Faith in Christ means we will not stand with the condemned at judgment (Rev. 20:11-15).
- C. The \_\_\_\_\_ (Isa. 55:7). Man must be willing to abandon wickedness and trust in Christ.

We often sing, "You ask me how I know He lives? He lives within my heart." When He lives \_\_\_\_\_ us we will have peace (John 14:27). We will have a peaceful \_\_\_\_\_ (Phil. 4:7). When Christ is with us we need not be \_\_\_\_\_ (Ps. 23:4).
