## God Shows No Partiality Acts 10:1-11:18

## **Main Point:**

Since God shows no partiality, you should be grateful to Him and do the same.

1. God wanted Peter to visit Cornelius, a Roman centurion.

2. God also wanted Peter to know that nothing is unclean anymore.

3. This is because God wanted to use Peter to welcome the Gentiles into His church.

**Dennis Johnson** "His gifts were a memorial offering, like the sacrifices presented by Israel to worship God and seek forgiveness (Lev. 2:2; 5:12). They were not the achievements of self-righteousness, but his heart-cries for rescue and atonement."

It leveled the playing field: the Jew could never legitimately claim, in himself, to be special or different from a Gentile!"
