-Paul's Apostolic Ministry

-Hebrews 3:1-3 (LSB) 1 Therefore, holy brothers, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession--Jesus, 2 who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was in all His house. 3 For He has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, in so much as the builder of the house has more honor than the house.

-John 4:34 (LSB) Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to finish His work.

-John 5:30 (LSB) "I can do nothing from Myself. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

-John 6:38 (LSB) "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

-Jesus had the testimony of:

-John 5:36-38 (LSB) 36 "But the witness I have is greater than the witness of John; for the works which the Father has given Me to finish--the very works that I do--bear witness about Me, that the Father has sent Me. 37 "And the Father who sent Me, He has borne witness about Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time nor seen His form. 38 "And you do not have His word abiding in you, for you do not believe Him whom He sent.

-John 5:46-47 (LSB) 46 "For if you believed Moses, you would believe Me, for he wrote about Me. 47 "But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe My words?"

-Three criteria:

-Eyewitness of the risen Lord Jesus

-Acts 1:21-22 (LSB) 21 "Therefore it is necessary that of the men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us-- 22 beginning with the baptism of John until the day that He was taken up from us--one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection."

-1 Corinthians 9:1 (LSB) Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are you not my work in the Lord?

-Galatians 1:1 (LSB) Paul, an apostle--not sent from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised Him from the dead--

-2 Corinthians 12:12 (LSB) The signs of a true apostle were worked out among you with all perseverance, by signs and wonders and miracles.

-He had to be appointed by the Lord Himself

-Acts 1:23-26 (LSB) 23 And they put forward two men, Joseph called Barsabbas (who was also called Justus), and Matthias. 24 And they prayed and said, "You, Lord, who know the hearts of all men, show which one of these two You have chosen 25 to take the place of this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." 26 And they cast lots for them, and the lot fell to Matthias; and he was added to the eleven apostles.

-He had to be empowered to perform signs and wonders
