This Generation Rejects John + Jesus

Matthew 11:18-19

For John came neither eating nor drinking, and **they say**, "He has a demon!" 19 The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and **they say**, "Behold, a gluttonous man and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!" Yet wisdom is vindicated by her deeds.

Applications

- 1. We should understand "this generation" as a quality of people who reject God's prophets, not a quantity of people living during a certain time.
- 2. We must "receive" God's revelation whether or not it seems distasteful to us.
- 3. We must know that true righteousness far exceeds man-made rules of food, drink, or asceticism.

Understanding "This Generation"

- **1. Quantity**: People alive during a certain time period.
- **2. Quality**: People characterized by lack of belief no matter when they lived.

Romans 14:16-17
