- John 5:22-23 For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son,
 ²³ so that all will honor the Son even as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. →Judgment of all mankind
- <u>1 Corinthians 3:10-15</u> According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it. ¹¹ For no one can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³ each man's work will become evident, for the day will indicate it because it is revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. ¹⁴ If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. →Judgment of believers

- <u>2 Corinthians 5:10</u> For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad. →Judgment of believers
- <u>Matthew 25:31-36</u> "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. ³² And all the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; ³³ and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left. ³⁴ "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom, which has been prepared for you from the foundation of the world. ³⁵ For I was hungry, and you gave Me *something* to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me *something* to drink; I was a stranger, and you invited Me in; ³⁶ naked, and you clothed Me; I was sick, and you visited Me; I was in prison, and you came to Me.'" → Judgment of living inhabitants of the earth at Jesus' glorious return

• Matthew 25:37-46 Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, and feed You, or thirsty, and give You something to drink? ³⁸ And when did we see You a stranger, and invite You in, or naked, and clothe You? ³⁹ And when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' ⁴⁰ And the King will answer and say to them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these brothers of Mine, even the least of them, you did it to Me.' ⁴¹ "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; ⁴² for I was hungry, and you gave Me nothing to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me nothing to drink; ⁴³ I was a stranger, and you did not invite Me in; naked, and you did not clothe Me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit Me.' ⁴⁴ Then they themselves also will answer, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not take care of You?' ⁴⁵ Then He will answer them, saying, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' ⁴⁶ And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." \rightarrow Judgment of living inhabitants of the earth at Jesus' glorious return

<u>Revelation 20:11-15</u> Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sits upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. ¹² Then I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life. And the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. ¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them, and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds. ¹⁴ Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. ¹⁵ And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

 \rightarrow Judgment of of the unbelieving dead at the Great White Throne

- <u>1 Timothy 2:5</u> For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the witness for this proper time.
- <u>Ephesians 1:22</u> And HE PUT ALL THINGS IN SUBJECTION UNDER HIS FEET, and gave Him as head over all things to the church
- <u>Ephesians 5:23</u> For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body.
- <u>Colossians 1:18</u> And He is the head of the body, the church;
- <u>Isaiah 9:6</u> For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷ There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of Yahweh of hosts will accomplish this.

- <u>Luke 1:31-33</u> And behold, you will conceive in *your* womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus. ³² He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David, ³³ and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and there will be no end of His kingdom."
- <u>Matthew 25:14-46</u> [Verses 31-46 were previously referenced and read. They also apply here. Note tie-in with the parable of the Talents in verses 14-30]
- <u>Acts 17:30-31</u> Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now commanding men that everyone everywhere should repent, ³¹ because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He determined, having furnished proof to all by raising Him from the dead."
