The incommunicable attributes

How is God different from us?

God's attributes, or perfections, are identical to His essence.

We must not consider these perfections without consciously thinking about how they integrate with, compliment, and qualify each other.

These perfections are directed first toward God before anything or anyone outside Him.

These perfections are defined and understood according to their presentation in Scripture, as the special revelation by God of Himself to us.

Independence (Aseity)

Aseity – Latin "self" in reference to the properties by which a being exists in and of itself.

God is independent of all things. He is perfectly self-sufficient, not depending on anything outside Himself for anything, and is therefore the eternal, foundational Being, the source of life and sustenance for all other beings. – MacArthur, pg. 168

Acts 17:24 God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands. 25 Nor is He worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things.

Job 41:11 Who has preceded Me, that I should pay him? Everything under heaven is Mine.
