March 2023 Update

Dear friends in Christ,

Car: We're super grateful that we got a car in late February. We were able to purchase a 7-passenger van, a 4-year old Ford Transit Connect. The extra seats allow us to add guests with family and use it as ministry, as several people in our church don't have cars and occasionally need rides.

Cards: We're grateful that we received our residency cards last week. We started the process for those before leaving the USA, about a year ago. The visas culminate in residency cards.

Contacts: We've had several good witnessing opportunities, mostly with unbelievers that have been attending church. Amy started a Bible study with a middle-age lady two weeks ago. She believes that "we just have to be good people." We ask God that she will keep gathering with our church and keep coming to the study, and that He will open her eyes. We are starting a Bible study this Friday evening, Lord-willing, with a young couple that has attended our church several times. Three weeks ago, a man who attends our church brought his brother to church, and we had an opportunity to witness to his unsaved brother over lunch. Yesterday, our neighbor, who helps maintain our landlords' properties came to fix something in our home, and as this was the third time he visited we know each other a little bit. He asked about the nature of our missionary work here. I was able to share the gospel with him some. Our prayer for all of them is that the Spirit would give them new life in Christ.

Church: We are still new to the church, but are quickly getting to know the members and enjoying the fellowship with them. We're grateful for the opportunity to serve our Lord here. We ask that you would pray for the spiritual growth of our church, and for our church to be a light to the lost around us.

Eye: Our little Sophia has had blocked glands in her lower left eyelid for a few months. We have been doing treatments and going to specialists to treat her eyelid. As she remains with the blockage, she possibly will have to undergo a minor surgery on her eyelid to treat those blockages. We appreciate your prayers for the healing of her eye, hopefully without surgery, and if necessary, for healing with surgery.

Soccer: I'm bummed that our weekly soccer gatherings have come to a halt. It is hard for some men to attend because of work schedules. I hope to find a solution to resume this activity and ministry.
