### Notes for Further Study

1. Read Psalm 110.
  - a. What is the point Jesus making about this person described as "Lord" in this Psalm?
  - b. Jesus has publicly acted out the role of Messiah in His entry into Jerusalem but has not yet declared His Messiahship. Read Mark 14:61-63. How did the leaders respond when He did claim to be the Messiah?
  - c. Read Acts 2:32-36. What does Peter say this passage prophesied about Jesus?
  - d. Read Hebrews 1:8-14. What does this passage tell us about Jesus (particularly in comparison to angels)?
2. Read Exodus 22:22-24. What is particularly egregious about the attitudes or actions Jesus claims the scribes have?
  - a. Read Jeremiah 7:1-7 and Ezekiel 22:6-12. What does God think of His people when they not only fail to care for the helpless but take advantage of them?
  - b. Read 1 Timothy 5:3-16. How are widows to be treated in the church?
3. Read Matthew 6:19-21. What does Jesus teach about "treasure?" How does that come into play in Mark 12:41-44?
  - a. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-7. How should we give?
  - b. Read Hebrews 13:15-16 and Luke 10:35 (in context). Have you ever given not just what was required but sacrificially?
