  - f. Does this passage teach that a believer today can lose his salvation through blaspheming against the Holy Spirit?**
  
- 2. Don't you have to ENDURE IN FAITH AND GODLINESS TO THE END of your life to be saved? (Matthew 24:13)**
  - a. When was this spoken, and by whom to who?**
  - b. What is Mt. 24 & 25 all about?**
  - c. Who is the "they" of vs. 13 referring to?**
  - d. What is the "end" in view in vs.13?**
  - e. What must they "endure"?**

- f. What is “saved” in reference to in this context?
  - g. Is this verse teaching that a believer must endure in faith and holiness to the end of his life to be saved from Hell?
3. What if you FAIL TO ABIDE IN CHRIST? (John 15:6)
- a. When did this occur?
  - b. What is the subject of Jesus Christ’s teaching?
  - c. Who is Christ teaching?
  - d. Why is Christ teaching this?
  - e. What is vs. 6 teaching?
  - f. Is this verse teaching that a believer must abide in Christ to avoid Hell?
4. What about JUDAS ISCARIOT? Didn’t he lose his salvation?
5. What if you become DISQUALIFIED? (1 Corinthians 9:27)
- a. What is the general context of 1 Corinthians 9?
  - b. What is the immediate context of 1 Corinthians 9:24-27?
  - c. Is this referring to believers or unbelievers?
  - d. Is he referring to the gift of salvation or to rewards for faithful service?
  - e. What does “disqualified” mean?
  - f. What exactly is this passage teaching and not teaching?
