#### Genesis 3:1-11

Why is God's question in verse 11 significant? What are the different sources of information presented in these verses? What are some possible emotions that Adam and Eve may have experienced by their disobedience? In what ways is the emotional impact of sin seen in people's lives today? How are unbiblical ideas spread today? What makes these ideas seem acceptable? In what ways did sin destroy the harmony in Adam and Eve's marital relationship? How do you see sin harming relationships today?

#### Psalm 1

What are the two sources of influence presented in this psalm? What are the differing results from heeding these sources? What can you learn about the Lord's involvement in the life of the person who delights in His Word? How can Psalm 119:24 & 128 encourage you to seek God's way?

#### Genesis 3:12-23

What excuses did Adam and Eve offer? Whom did God hold accountable for the disobedience in the Garden? How is God's mercy evidenced in these verses? Genesis 3:15 is considered to be the first statement of the Gospel message. What hope can you glean from this verse? People all around you are trying to make life work, but they are getting their information from the wrong sources. Will you pray for opportunities to share the hope of Christ with someone this week?
