Sermon: "You Had One Job!" Resurrection Sunday 2022

I Text:

Old Covenant: Isaiah 53

New Covenant: 1 Corinthians 11:17-33

II Doctrine:

"You Had One Job" is a popular saying in western culture to express the failure of someone to complete a task they were given. The task is often simple to remember and essential to the goal your team is trying to achieve. Christians often overlook the fundamental task of witnessing to everyone regarding Christ's resurrection. Both unbelievers and "backsliders" need to hear the Gospel story. Modern evangelicals have embraced every social cause of the world, and have forgotten the one job they had. They no longer project a victorious risen Messiah, who's commands we must obey!

The 'Gospel of Isaiah" explains how the Messiah will rescue his people for time and eternity. We must inculcate this story in everyone around us. Let us not squander the chance we have to still speak of Christ in America, especially during the "Easter" season.
