III. Winning Requires Direction - v. 26-27

What did it mean for Paul to run with aim?

- He ran to please the judge, not the crowd (2 Corinthians 5:9).
- He focused on the finish line, not the past (Philippians 3:12-14).
- He focused on winning the lost, not gaining the world (1 Corinthians 9:19)
- He desired to glorify god, and not himself (1 Corinthians 10:31).

A long obedience in the RIGHT direction.
