At Caesarea Philippi Jesus said, "on this rock, I will build my church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." Matthew 16:18

What does "on this rock" mean?

Tell me about Caesarea Philippi.

Sin has brought division and warfare to God's creation.

We should expect conflict, but we should also expect victory.

Who was Herod (Agrippa 1)?

Marcus Julius Agrippa, 10BC - 44Ad

As king, he eagerly sought the approval of the Jewish people.

Herod martyred James, and Peter was next.

Peter was in prison securely guarded. Why? (Acts 5:17-21)

The Church's response to Persecution from the State

Earnest Prayer v 5

Angel Comes to Peter

Wakes him up, on the day before his execution.

Peter Goes to Church

Rhoda reports that Peter is here, no one believes her.

Herod Reacts

Searches for Peter, kills the guards and runs off to Caesarea.

Herod, and Tyre and Sidon

Herod at a feast rose to give a speech to those from Tyre and Sidon.

The Spiritual Autopsy determined the cause of death; pride. Isa 14:17

Our text closes with these familiar words throughout the book of Acts, "the Word of God increased and multiplied:

We are at war - and we shall prevail!

The gates of hell shall not stand against the triumph of God through his church.
