## **Principles of Application**

What does it say? (What did it mean?)

Example: 1 Corinthians 5:9–13

Application is connected to \_\_\_\_\_\_. (What does it mean to me?)

Application must flow from right

• All doctrine is . (Titus 1:7–9; 2:1–10

"All doctrine is practical, and all practice must be based on sound doctrine. Doctrine that is not practical is not healthy doctrine and practice that is not doctrinal is not rightly based."<sup>†</sup>

#### 1 Timothy 5:17-20 (NKJV)

17 Let the elders who rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in the word and doctrine. 18 For the Scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain," and, "The laborer is worthy of his wages." 19 Do not receive an accusation against an elder except from two or three witnesses. 20 Those who are sinning rebuke in the presence of all, that the rest also may fear.
