- The disciples want to know the <u>cause</u> of the blindness

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- Eve multiply your pain in childbearing
- Adam cursed is the ground because of you

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- Generally, suffering did come into the world because of sin
- But...specific sin doesn't always mean specific suffering

- The reason for his suffering all these years since birth, is so God can be glorified

1 John 1:5 - This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

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v. 7 - ...and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

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- God was the cause!

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- He was designed that way!
- And so were you!

Exodus 4:10-11 - But Moses said to the Lord, "Oh, my Lord, I am not eloquent, either in the past or since you have spoken to your servant, but I am slow of speech and of tongue."

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11 Then the Lord said to him, "Who has made man's mouth? Who makes him mute, or deaf, or seeing, or blind? Is it not I, the Lord?

Psalm 139:13 - For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb.

- There is no child created outside of God's purpose
- There is no suffering outside of God's purpose

Isaiah 46:8-11 - "Remember this and stand firm, recall it to mind, you transgressors, 9 remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, 10 declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,' 11 calling a bird of prey from the east, the man of my counsel from a far country. I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it.

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 God is trying tell us that we need to understand what it means to be God Isaiah 46:9 - remember the former things of old; for <u>I am</u> <u>God</u>, and there is no other; <u>I am God</u>, and there is none like me,

What does it mean to be the one and only God?

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- Including human events

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- The future is the purpose of God, being accomplished by God – John Piper

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Isaiah 46:11 - ... I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it.

- The reason God's prophecies come true is because they are His purposes, and He accomplishes them
- There is nothing that comes about that God does not purpose to happen
- Everything that has ever happened or will happen, God designed it that way

- When you try to understand God's sovereignty, it will be overwhelming
- You will rebel against the idea

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- You will rebel against the idea
- As you mature in your walk, the sovereignty of God will become a pillar you cling to
- It provides comfort in hard times
- Do you want a God that is not fully in control? (what does it mean to be God?)

We have 2 choices when we finally come to grips with God's sovereignty

- worship an absolute sovereign God (master, Lord)
- resist God and think we can do it better

Proverbs 16:33 - The lot is cast into the lap, but its every decision is from the Lord.

- There is no storm, no tornado, no shooting, no global pandemic that God cannot simply say "Peace! Be still!" and it would obey!

- snow, frost, cold, wind, water, clouds, rain, pandemics, rulers authority, all because God caused them to happen
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- If God is the one who planned and then accomplishes this suffering, then there must be a reason
- That reason is so that the works of God can be put on display

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- God revealing Himself to us forces everyone to place
 God on the scales
- We can value Him more than anything else, or we can deny Him and trust in ourselves to control things

- As we read John 9, as God reveals Himself over the chapter, we will see that the person who has suffered values God the most
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- God gets the most glory through he one who suffers
