## "The Pilgrims Progress" The Hill Of Difficulty (Page 22-23)

## **Introduction:**

- 1. To Begin Our Time Tonight:
  - Let's Open Our Bibles To:
    - The Gospel Of John:
      - John 16:33 Where Just As Jesus Is About:
        - To Face His Own Affliction:
          - On The Cross Of Calvary!
        - As Usual He Thinks Not Of Himself:
          - But Of His Disciples:
            - And What They Will Face When He Would Leave Them:
              - In This World!
- 2. He Said To Them As Well As To Us:
  - "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world!"
    - The Disciples He Was Speaking To:
      - Had Already Found In Jesus:
        - The "Peace Which Passeth All Understanding!"
    - As We Learned This Morning:
      - It Was An:
        - Upward Peace:
          - With God!
      - As Well As An:
        - Inward Peace:
          - In Their Hearts!
  - But It Was Not Yet Time For:
    - The Outward Peace:
      - That Would & Will Come:
        - When Our Work In This World:
          - Is Done!
- 3. And So He Sought To Comfort Them!
  - Because He Knew That:
    - "In The World Ye Shall Have Tribulation!"
      - And What Was True For:
        - His Disciples Then Is Still True:
          - For His Disciples Today!
  - "In The World Ye Shall Have Tribulation!"
    - The Word Translated "Tribulation" Here:
      - Means Affliction & Trouble:
        - Of Any Kind!
          - Anything That Might Cause Pressure & Distress & Difficulty:
            - In Your Life!

- It Can Refer To:
  - The Physical Difficulties:
    - In Your Life!
      - The Challenges You Face:
        - Because You Live In A Fallen World:
          - In A Fallen Body!

- It Can Also Refer To:
  - The Mental & Emotional Difficulties:
    - In Your Life!
      - The Distress You May Face:
        - Because Of Sorrow & Pain, As Well As Anxiety & Grief!
- It Can Also Refer To:
  - The Natural Stresses:

- That Everyone Goes Through:
  - In Their Lives!
- Family Issues!
  - Financial Needs!
    - Future Concerns!
      - Even This Pandemic We've Been Living Through:
        - Is A Tribulation To Us!

- It Can Also Refer To:
  - The Spiritual Challenges:
    - That Comes About When:
      - A "New Creature" In Christ:
        - Is Attacked By:
          - The Old Man, The Old World, And The Old Serpent Himself!
- 4. In The Pilgrim's Progress:
  - John Bunyan Describes This Kind Of Tribulation:
    - As "The Hill Of Difficulty!"
      - And As It Was For Christian:
        - It Is A Hill That:
          - Every Christian Must Climb:
            - On Their Pilgrimage To The Celestial City!
  - And It May Even Be A Hill:
    - That You Have To Scale:
      - More Than Once!
- 5. And So As We Head Back To:
  - Our Story We Find Christian:
    - After His "Reality Check" Which Came About:
      - When He Met Up With:
        - Those Five Men With The Names:
          - Simple, Sloth, & Presumption, As Well As Formality & Hypocrisy!
  - He Comes Up To:
    - One Of Those Hills:
      - That Jesus Himself Said He Would:
        - And We Would Face!
    - So Starting On Page 22, Last Paragraph:
      - We Read "I Beheld, Then, That They All Went On Till Thy Came To The Foot Of The Hill Difficulty!"
        - Continue To Page 23, Paragraph 3:
          - "And With That Christian Suddenly Started Up, And Sped Him On His Way, And Went Apace, Till He Came To The Top Of The Hill!"
- 6. So Even Though:
  - Three Men Arrived At:
    - "The Foot Of The Hill" As We Just Read:
      - Only One Christian:
        - "Came To The Top!"
  - And The Reason For This Is:
    - Noone Likes Difficulty In Their Lives!
      - Noone Looks Forward To Tribulation:
        - In Any Way!
          - Whether That Be Physical Or Mental Or Emotional Or Natural Or Spiritual Problems & Afflictions!
    - Noone Wants To:
      - Hear That They Have Been Diagnosed:
        - With An Incurable Disease!
    - Noone Looks Forward To:
      - Hearing That Their Son Or Daughter:
        - Was Killed In Their Workplace:
          - By A Gunman!
    - Noone Wants To:

- Open Up Their Mail - Only To Find: - Another Medical Bill - To The Tune Of: - Thousands Of Dollars: - Which They Still Can't Pay! Noone Wants To Climb: - The Hill Of Difficulty! - Perhaps This Is One Of The Reasons Why: - Nathaniel Hawthorne: - The Same Author Who Wrote: - That Story Beloved By All High-School Students Who Were Forced To Read - "The Scarlet Letter!" - He Also Wrote A Parody: - Of The Pilgrim's Progress Titled: - "The Celestial Railroad!" - Which Has Christian: - Instead Of Climbing Up & Over This Hill: - It Has Him Riding A Train Through A Tunnel Bored Straight Through It! Noone Wants To: - Climb The Hill Of Difficulty! - But All Of Us Have To! - And So - God Has Given His People: - A Very Special Word Of Comfort & Promise! - Also Found In: - John 16:33 - Where Jesus Adds: - "But Be Of Good Cheer; I Have Overcome The World!" And So - As We Reflect On: - The Words Of Jesus - That Are: - Illustrated For Us By This Hill Of Difficulty: - There Are Four Things That: - By God's Grace: - We Need To Keep Doing: - So That We Too Can Make It "To The Top Of The Hill!" \* First: Keep Preparing! - Keep Preparing For The Hill Of Difficulty! - After Formality & Hypocrisy: - Went Off In Different Directions: - In Order To Avoid This Hill: - Christian Stood Alone: - At The Bottom! - But - He Was Ready! Why? - Because - Did You Notice? - There Was A "Spring" There! – And - He Alone: - "Drank Thereof, To Refresh Himself!" - And It Was The Water: - From That Spring: - That Prepared Him To Face: - That Hill Of Difficulty: - With Strength & Vitality From The Lord! - What Was In That Water?

> - Electrolytes? Minerals? Caffeine? - No! In That Water:

> > - There Were Reminders:

- Of God's Grace To Help In Time Of Need!

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- That Water Helped Christian:
- Remember God's Providence!
  - Bunyan Uses This Spring:
    - To Remind Us Of What The Lord Says About His People:
      - In Isaiah 49:10 "They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them!"
  - The Spring Of God's Grace:
    - Is An Infinite Spring:
      - Which Will Prepare Us To Face:
        - Any Hill:
          - Of Difficulty!
        - As Well As Any:
          - Meadow Of Peace!
  - We Need To Remember:
    - That Everything We Face In This World:
      - Is In The Palm Of God's Hand!
        - And He Is The One:
          - Who Will Help You Through!
  - That Water Also Helped Christian:
- Remember God's Promises!
  - Exceeding Great And Precious Promises:
    - Like The Promise We Find In:
      - Isaiah 43 "I Will Be With Thee!"
  - Isaiah 43:1-3 "But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine. / When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee. / For I am the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour!"
    - And I Think We Can Add To this:
      - When You Climb The Hill Of Difficulty!
- So Keep Preparing:
  - For The Hill Of Difficulty!
    - You May Not See One Yet Or:
      - Maybe You Are On One But:
        - There's A Bigger One To Come!
  - Keep Preparing For It:
    - By Drinking From The Spring Of Living Water!
      - Keep Trusting In:
        - God's Sovereign Control:
          - In Your Life And:
      - Keep Feeding On:
        - God's Precious Promises!
  - You Will Need Them Soon Enough!
    - And God Is Gracious:
      - To Provide Them To You!

- 2. Keep Plodding!
  - Keep Plodding On When You Reach The Hill Of Difficulty!
    - Even Though We Are Told That:
      - Christian Started Running Up That Hill:
        - What Soon Happened?
          - "He Fell From Running To Going, And From Going To Clambering Upon His Hands And Knees, Because Of The Steepness Of The Place!"
    - The Truth Is The Christian Life:
      - Is Not Easy!
        - The Christian Road:

- Is Often Very, Very Hard!
- A Few Years Back I Remember The Ladies:
  - Singing A Song Titled:
    - "Its Not An Easy Road!"
  - "It's Not An Easy Road We Are Travelling To Heaven / For Many Are The Thorns On The Way. / Its Not An Easy Road, But The Savior Is With Us, / His Presence Gives Us Joy Every Day!" (John Peterson)
- So Often We Think Of Verses:
  - Like Isaiah 40:31:
    - "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles!"
      - But If You Go On In The Verse:
        - Isaiah Seems To Recognize The Tendency To Slow Down & Struggle As Well!
  - Because Even Though You May Start Up The Hill Of Difficulty:
    - "With Wings As Eagles!"
      - But Then You Might Fall From The Sky:
        - And Have To Run On Your Feet!
          - And Even Then, You Might Be Forced To A Walk & Then To A Crawl!
  - But The Promise To Those Who Know:
    - The Lord And Are Trusting In Jesus:
      - Is That Even If They:
        - Run They Do Not Need To Be Weary!
      - And If They:
        - Walk They Do Not Need To Faint!
    - Because The "Lord Shall Renew Their Strength!"
- And How Did The Lord:
  - Renew Christian's Strength:
    - On That Hill Of Difficulty?
      - Bunyan Tells Us That "About Midway To The Top Of The Hill Was a Pleasant Arbour, Made By The Lord Of The Hill For The Refreshing Of Weary Travellers!"
- When You Find Yourself:
  - Slowing Down From:
    - Flying Up The Mountain To:
      - Running Up It To:
        - Walking & Then Even:
          - Crawling!
  - Be Patient & Keep Plodding!
    - Because There Are Places Even On That Hill:
      - Where You Can Find Rest & Refreshment:
        - From The Lord!
- Now Some People:
  - Don't Rest Enough:
    - In What God In His Grace Has Given To Them:
      - To Refresh Their Souls!
  - Like His Special Son!
    - Matthew 11:28 "Come unto me, all [ye] that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest!"
  - Also: His Special Word!
    - His Special Day!
      - His Special People!
  - Even In The Hill Of Difficulty:
    - You Need To Take Time To:
      - "Be Still And Know That I Am God!"
        - But Don't Be Too Still!
          - Because That Can Be A Problem Too! It Was A Problem Christian Faced!

- \* And So Not Only Do You Need To Keep Patiently Plodding You Also Need To: Keep Pressing! 3. - As Paul Puts It In: - Philippians 3:14 - Keep Pressing: - "Toward The Mark For The Prize Of The High Calling Of God In Christ Jesus!" - Like Christian: - One Of The Things We Often Forget: - Is That There Is A Summit: - On Those Hills Of Difficulty: - That We Face! - And So - You Must Not: - Let Your Guard Down: - When God Graciously Provides: - Refreshment To Your: - Weary Soul! - As John Kelman Once Wrote: - Sometimes - "It Is Easy To Rest Too Long And Too Deeply!" - So Keep Pressing On! - There Is A Top To The Hill! - There Is An End To Tribulation! - There Is Even An Escape: - To The Temptations You Face In Your Life! - Even As The Apostle Paul Tells Us: - In 1 Corinthians 10:12 - "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it!" - But - Even When We Do: - Fall "Into A Slumber" - God Is Still Gracious: - To Chasten Us! - To Wake Us Up! And: - To Remind Us Of His Truth! - Christian Heard The Words Of: - Proverbs 6:6 - "Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise!" - "And With That" - Bunyan Writes - "Christian Suddenly Started Up, And Sped Him On His Way, And Went Apace, Till He Came To The Top Of The Hill!" - But - As We Will Discover Next Week: - He Is Not Ouite Done: - With That Hill Of Difficulty! - Because He Lost Something: - Very Special & Very Important: - When He Was Asleep In That Arbor! \* And That Is Why - Even When The Hill Of Difficulty Seems To Be Past - We Need To Continue To: Keep Patrolling! - Keep Patrolling Your Heart! - Proverbs 4:23 - "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life!"
  - Keep Patrolling Your Heart!
    - Because How Many Times:
      - Have People Fallen:
        - When Things Seemed To Get Easier Or:
          - When The End Of A Trial:
            - Was In Sight!
    - They Let Their Guard Down!
      - **IE:** Sometimes This Happens In A Race! A Runner Slows Down, Only To Be Passed At The Last Second! A Driver Takes His Foot Of The Gas, Only To Find Another Driver Taking The Checkered Flag!
  - Isn't This What Happened:
    - In The Life Of King David?

- After Years Of Battle:
  - He Found Time & Place For Ease:
    - In The Palace He Had Built For Himself:
      - In Jerusalem!
- And So As We Are Familiarly Told:
  - In 2 Samuel 11:1 "At The Time When Kings Go Forth To Battle David Tarried Still At Jerusalem!"
    - He Stopped Patrolling & Guarding His Heart!
      - And So He Sinned Against The Lord And Lost Something:
        - Very Special & Very Important:
          - On That Hill Of Difficulty Called Temptation!

    - The Next Hill Of Difficulty:
      - That You Must Climb?
        - Keep These Lessons:
          - From Our Pilgrim In Your Mind!
  - Keep Preparing!

  - Keep Plodding!
    - By Relying On The Lord & His Strength!
      - Hebrew 4:16 "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need!"
  - Keep Pressing On!
    - 2 Thessalonians 3:13 "Be Not Weary In Well Doing!"
      - And:
  - And Keep Patrolling:
    - Your Heart!
- 2. And You Can Do So:
  - With A Smile In Your Heart!
    - Because As Jesus Said:
      - In John 16:33 "In The World Ye Shall Have Tribulation / Affliction! But Be Of Good Cheer; I Have Overcome The World!"
