## IV. BRIEF OVERVIEW OF SIGNIFICANT HISTORICAL DATES

- **1929** Great Depression begins with Wall Street crash, Oct 24-29
- 1931 China proclaimed communist state by Mao Tze-tung, Nov 7
- 1932 Brave New World published by Aldous Huxley,
- 1933 Adolph Hitler becomes Chancellor of Germany, Jan 30
- 1939 World War II begins with Germany invading Poland, Sep 1
- 1941 Japanese attack US bases, Dec 7; US officially enters WW2
- 1945 End of WW2 in Europe, May; End of WW2 in Asia, Sep 2
- **1948** Israel officially becomes an independent state, May 14
- 1949 1984 published by George Orwell, June 8
- 1950 North Korea invades South Korea, Jun 25; Korean War begins
- 1953 Korean War ends, Jul 27
- 1957 Space Age begins with launch of Sputnik 1, Oct 4
- 1959 Alaska becomes 49th state, Jul 4; Vietnam War begins, Nov 1
- 1960 Valdivia, Chile earthquake (9.6, highest recorded), May 22
- 1963 John F. Kennedy, 35th US president, assassinated, Nov 22
- 1966 Church of Satan, San Francisco, established by Anton LaVey, Apr 30
- 1967 Arab-Israeli Six-Day War begins, Jun 5
- 1973 Yom Kippur War, Oct 6-25
- 1975 Vietnam War ends with fall of Saigon, Apr 30
- 1978 War in Afghanistan begins, Apr 27
- 1990 Communism ends in Russia, Feb 7
- 2000 Pope John Paul II apologizes for Roman Catholic wrongdoings, Mar 12
- 2001 Attacks on World Trade Center & U.S. Pentagon, Sep 11
- 2002 Euro enters circulation, Jan 1
- 2009 Bitcoin crytocurrency is launched, Jan 3
- 2011 9.0 Tohuku quake in Japan triggers Fukushima Nuclear meltdown, Mar 11
