- 1) Listen to the voices that encourage you to believe
 - a) The voice of **reason** - Mt 27:18
 - b) The voice of **love** - Mt. 27:19
 - c) The voice of **honesty** - *Luke 23:4; Matt 27:23*
 - d) The voice of **Deity** - John 18:36-37
- 2) Reject the voices that discourage you from believing.
 - a) Disregard the voice of **current culture** - Mark 15:15
 - b) Dismiss the voice of **pride**. Jn. 19:10
 - c) Ignore the voices of **position** and temporary **possessions** - Jn 19:12
- 3) Don't render a verdict that condemns you.
 - a) You can't **ignore** Him.
 - b) You can't **deflect** Him
 - c) You can't merely **admire** Him.
 - d) You can't remain **neutral**. Matt 12:30.
