

WHY SHE ISN'T MARRIED (IMMODEST DRESS AND LIFE)

TEXT: 1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array; 10 But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.

1 Timothy 5:14 I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

1. No Desire: (Propaganda from devils and fallen culture; deception/trick).

2. God's Timing: (i.e., preparation of you or your future spouse, etc.; suffering/trial for reasons unknown for God's glory; discipline, etc.).

3. Immodesty:

B. 1 Peter 3:3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;

2 Samuel 1:24 Ye daughters of Israel, weep over Saul, who clothed you in scarlet, with other delights, who put on ornaments of gold upon your apparel.

2 Samuel 13:18 And she had a garment of divers colours upon her: for with such robes were the king's daughters that were virgins apparelled...

2 Samuel 12:20 Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed himself, and changed his apparel...

"Of female attire: decent; not meretricious." (Oxford Dictionary)

Meretricious:

- "a. L. meretricius, from meretrix, a prostitute.
- 1. Pertaining to prostitutes; such as in practiced by harlots..."

Titus 2:5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

1 Peter 3:2 While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.

"...French chaste 'morally pure' (12c.), from Latin castus 'clean, pure, morally pure'...Of language, etc., 'free from obscenity,' 1620s..." (Etymology Online)

Lamentations 1:8 Jerusalem hath grievously sinned; therefore she is removed: all that honoured her despise her, because they have seen her nakedness...

Isaiah 47:3 Thy nakedness shall be uncovered, yea, thy shame shall be seen...
