WHEN *NO* IS NOT ENOUGH!

Judges 15:12 And they said unto him, We are come down to bind thee, that we may deliver thee into the hand of the Philistines. And Samson said unto them, Swear unto me, that ye will not fall upon me yourselves.

13 And they spake unto him, **saying, No**; but we will bind thee fast, and deliver thee into their hand: but surely we will not kill thee...

1 Samuel 1:14 And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee.

15 And Hannah answered and said, **No, my lord**, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

16 Count not thine handmaid for a daughter of Belial...

1 Kings 3:22...And this **said, No**; but the dead is thy son, and the living is my son. Thus they spake before the king.

Isaiah 30:15 For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not.

16 But **ye said, No**; for we will flee upon horses; therefore shall ye flee: and, We will ride upon the swift; therefore shall they that pursue you be swift.

"Good usage to a servant does not mean indulgence, which would ruin even a child. The body is a servant to the soul; those that humour it, and are over-tender of it, will find it forget its place..."

"Eli shunned trouble and exertion. This led him to indulge his children, without using parental authority to restrain and correct them when young...Eli's reproof was far too mild and gentle."

JFB Commentary:

"He erred on the side of parental indulgence; and though he reprimanded them...he shrank from laying on them the restraints, or subjecting them to the discipline, their gross delinquencies called for."

John Gill:

"Nay, my sons,.... This seems to be too soft and smooth...too kind..."

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.

Proverbs 29:17 Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.

Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the **rod of correction** shall drive it far from him.
