

***The Day of the LORD***  
**Ezekiel 30:1-26**

Main Point:

Receive salvation, instead of judgment, on the Day of the LORD by trusting in Christ alone.

1. The Day of the LORD will come.
2. The Day of the LORD will be unbearable and unavoidable.
3. The Day of the LORD will be effectively carried out by God's agent.
4. The Day of the LORD will be for salvation if your faith has the right object.

**2 Peter 3:10** 10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. (NKJV)

**Revelation 22:12** 12 “Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay each one for what he has done. (ESV)

**1 Thessalonians 5:2-3** 2 For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. 3 For when they say, “Peace and safety!” then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape. (NKJV)

**John 5:26-27** 26 For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself, 27 and has given Him authority to execute judgment also ... (NKJV)
