Jesus Christ Is Risen: Peace, Power & Purpose (John 20:19-23)

- New Testament: 27 books all deal with Jesus life, death & resurrection
- All deal with Jesus risen from the dead & living reality in the universe
- Jesus' first appearance to all of his disciples together for the first time.
- We will consider how the risen Jesus responded to his disciples
- And we will consider also What words did the risen Jesus speak to his disciples?

I. Three Realities of How Jesus deals with His disciples & with us (19)

- 1) The doors were shut. (Luke 24:39)
- 2) They were fearful. (Isa 41:10)
- 3) Jesus came and stood in their midst

II. Three Blessings Jesus Speaks & Gives to His Disciples (20-23)

- 1) "Peace be with you"
 - a) Jesus purchased and accomplished peace for us on the cross (20)
 - b) Where peace comes into our lives
 - i. Peace between us and Him
 - ii. Peace between us and God
 - iii. Peace between us and others in Christ
 - iv. Peace between us and our own souls
 - v. *Peace with creation or the created order* (Isaiah 9:7)
 - c) How does this peace become yours? (John 1:12; Rom 5:1)
- 2) Empowered by the Holy Spirit (v.22 cf. Acts 1:8; 2:33)
- 3) The purpose He has for us (21b)

- Whoever doesn't listen to the Gospel & believe, their sins: not forgiven
