Hermeneutics is the science of Biblical Interpretation.

HOW TO DISCERN THE BIBLE

- I. THE PLAN FOR BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION (2:15e)

You will be able to properly understand the Bible.

To “*rightly divide the word of truth.*” means “to cut straight”. Paul was a tentmaker by trade and he used this type of terminology here.

“So, because he was of the same trade, he stayed with them and worked; for by occupation they were tentmakers.”
Acts 18:3

“97 Oh, how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day.

98 You, through Your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; For they are ever with me.

99 I have more understanding than all my teachers, For Your testimonies are my meditation.

100 I understand more than the ancients, Because I keep Your precepts.”
Psalm 119:97-100

You will be able to properly instruct others in the Bible.

“12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food.

13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.

14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.”

Hebrews 5:12-14

“And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” II Timothy 2:2

The Bible should be like a running stream, not a stagnant pool, in your life.

II. THE PRIORITY OF BIBLE INTERPRETATION

(2:14, 16-18)

A. Incorrect interpretation causes doubt (v14)

“Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?’”

Genesis 3:1

“So they read distinctly from the book, in the Law of God; and they gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading.”

Nehemiah 8:8

B. Incorrect interpretation causes disease (2:16-17a)

See Galatians 1:6-12

C. Incorrect interpretation causes damage (2:17b-18)

“18 This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good

*warfare,
19 having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith
have suffered shipwreck,*

*20 of whom are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I delivered to Satan that
they may learn not to blaspheme.”* I Timothy 1:18-20

*“29 For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in
among you, not sparing the flock. 30 Also from among yourselves men will
rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after
themselves. 31 Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did
not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears.*

*32 So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace,
which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those
who are sanctified.”* Acts 20:29-32
