- 9. What prophetic role did this person fulfill in God's plan of redemption (v. 14)?
- 10. How did Jesus compare His generation in terms of their response to His ministry and that of the one sent by God to announce the Messiah's coming (vv. 16-17)?
- 11. What did the crowds say about John the Baptist? Why (v. 18)? About Jesus? Why (v. 19a)?
- 12. What is proved right or vindicated by what it does (v. 19b)?
- 13. How it is that John was greater than anyone who lived in the Old Testament age?
- 14. How can someone who belongs to the New Covenant Church be greater than John?
- 15. As a Christian, what do you have that John and the saints of the Old Testament did not have?
- 16. What did John the Baptist do when doubts arose in his mind about Jesus?

- 17. Is it surprising to you that John the Baptist had doubts about Jesus? Why or why not?
- 18. Do you ever have doubts about Jesus and God's will for your life?
- 19. What doubts about Jesus have you had or perhaps have now?
