QUESTIONS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP

- 1. What is the particular setting that the ninth commandment narrowly focuses upon?
- 2. What is perjury, and why is it the prime example of all forms of lying?
- 3. How does the fear of man undergird and fuel our lying tongues?
- 4. What are some ways we commonly exaggerate? Is exaggeration itself sinful?
- 5. How does speaking truth in temporal things prepare us to speak truth in eternal things?
- 6. James says that no one is able to tame their tongue (James 3). Does that mean we are hopelessly given over to lying, slander, and gossip?

QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE REFLECTION

- 1. Do I have the tendency to intentionally exaggerate for selfish ends? Do I see the sinfulness of this?
- 2. Is my word dependable? Do I carry through with my commitments?
- 3. Do I use my lips to slander or gossip or willingly offer my ears to the slander or gossip of others?
- 4. Do I know what it is to have my heart cleansed of guilt and transformed through the word of truth so that my lips are increasingly speaking truth?
