Sermon: The Highest Calling. "The Faithful Outcasts" Pt.13

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Exodus 28:1-5* New Covenant: *Hebrews 5:1-10*

II Doctrine:

The Lord Jesus Christ as the God-Man was called to be a High Priest like the sons of Aaron. He was the perfect Priest in the flesh to provide an atonement. He was tempted and suffered in the flesh like a man, yet as the perfect High priest never sinned. In thought, word, and deed, our Lord was perfectly clean.

Our Lord shared similarities with the Sons of Aaron in his priesthood, but there were major differences. Like Melchizedek he was the Priest-King for the most high. He also would not retire from his office like a typical Levitical priest, but remained one forever! Jesus the Messiah sits at the right hand of the father as the perpetual King-Priest. All who claim the title after him are pretenders, and will burn in the Lake of fire!

Servants of God should emulate our Lord in their life. A horrible judgment awaits those in leadership who blaspheme God's name through their behavior and teachings.
