## **Application Questions**

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **1 Timothy 6:13-16**. How do you think all this lofty language about Jesus' exalted authority sits with the average American in the twenty-first century? Why do you think people are more averse to this now than ever?
- 2. Read **Psalm 23:1-6**. When you read this familiar psalm, how do you see the importance of Christ's authority over the lives of his people (here analogized as sheep) as necessary, needed, and vital to the well-being of all people?
- 3. Read **Luke 14:25-33**. Why is it indispensable to consider at least some of the varied implications of Christ's absolute leadership over one's life before just rushing into a relationship with Jesus in hopes of gaining all the associated benefits of being a Christian?
- 4. Read **Revelation 1:12-18**. How does this passage help you to see the importance of being rightly related to the "resurrected One" who will be in charge (i.e., "with the keys") of the ultimate destinies of all human beings?
- 5. Read **Isaiah 40:9-15**. Back to the Shepherd analogy. How does considering the unrivaled authority of Christ at his coming make his merciful love and generous forgiveness so much more valuable to Christians?
