- Blinding light
- Loud voice
- Bird call
- The Great Supper of God, 17b-18
 - Invitation to the turkey vultures
 - o Ezekiel 39.17ff: Ezekiel describes a similar battle
- History's opposition to God's kingdom is constant
- The battle scene, 19
 - o The battle is over in the blink of an eye
 - No battle even described

The Capture, 20

- Two great enemies of Jesus and the church: the Beast and false prophet
- Beast: world governments
- False prophet: false religions
- All opposed to Jesus.
- Radical secularism and the state demanding worship are false religions

The followers of the Beast and prophet, 21

- A horrific picture
- This is not just a singular end of history battle
- This is a battle raging around us all the time.

The really good news

- Jesus wins
 - Jesus won at the cross
 - o The Beast and false prophet will be cast into the eternal lake of fire, cf. Daniel 7.11
 - Their followers will become Bird food
- Reflecting on the power of God's word
 - Now implementing his victory in history
 - Hebrews 10.31
 - o Isaiah 63.1-6
- The great parody: The Great Supper of God is a parody of the Wedding Supper of the Lamb
 - o Either have an invitation to the Wedding Supper...
 - Or on the menu at the Great Supper
- Receive the invitation to the Wedding Supper through faith in Jesus Christ
