Parallel passage Jude & 2 Peter 2 focus on false believers

Madness, παραφρονία, paraphronia

- (from para, "contrary to," and phren, "the mind")

Balaam, Numbers 22-24

- Israelites camping on the plains of Moab
- Balak, king of Moab, desires to pay Balaam to curse Israelites
- Balaam claims that God is the "Lord my God"
- Balaam blesses Israel rather than curses them
- Was Balaam going to serve and obey God?
 - Deuteronomy 23:5
 - Numbers 25:1-9
 - Numbers 31:16
- The end of Balaam, Numbers 31:8
- Tell Deir Jordan, 1967

Hamartiology

- Greek: ἀμαρτία, hamartia, "missing the mark"
- Sin is any personal lack of conformity to the moral character of God, or the law of God.
- God is the Creator, man is the created, God has the right to tell us what to do
- Origination of sin
- Man, Romans 5:12, Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned
- Satan, Ezekiel 28, You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created until unrighteousness was found in you.
- Result of sin
 - Relational problem
 - Judicial problem
 - James 2:10, For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all
 - Eternal judgment for Satan, the fallen angels (demons), men and women

Levels of madness

- 1) Post-Adam, the conscience, nature
 - Romans 2:14-15
 - Romans 1:20
 - Martin Luther, "To act against conscience is neither right nor safe."
- 2) Post-Moses, the law
 - The standard of God
 - Varying degrees of sin
- 3) Post-Christ, the heart of the matter
 - Not just external, Matthew 5:21-22; 27-28
 - Even greater condemnation, Matthew 10:14-15
 - Law of Moses and the Son of God, Hebrews 10:28-31

The most irrational, the most insane, the maddest of all sinners

- No condemnation, but the greater condemnation
- The past is the past
- "Gracious" sinner
- Indifference to the gospel
- 1 Peter 1:12, the angelic view of the gospel

He could have let us all go
