- 2. An Emotional ANSWER... "Certainly not!" (vs. 2a)
- 3. A Theological REASON... "How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?" (vs. 2b)
- 4. A Doctrinal EXPLANATION (vs. 3-5)
- 5. The Important RAMIFICATIONS. (vs. 6-10)
