- 2. Plan how to do it

How should we meditate on Scripture?

- 1. Ask important questions
 - a. How does this fit with redemption?
 - b. What is the relationship to Christ?
 - c. What does it say about God?
 - d. What did it say to the original readers?
 - e. Are there commands to obey?
 - f. Are there sins to confess or forsake?
 - g. Are there errors to avoid?
 - h. Are there emotions to be felt?
 - i. Are there promises to believe?
- 2. Make general observations
- 3. Repeat the passage with a different emphasis on the words
- 4. Write the passage in your own words
- 5. Pray through the passage
- 6. Apply the passage to you
