**Luke 11:52 Woe unto  
you, lawyers! for ye  
have taken away the  
key of knowledge...**

Isaiah 40:3 The voice of him  
that crieth in the wilderness,  
**Prepare ye the way of the**  
**LORD**, make straight in the  
desert a highway for our God.

**Malachi 3:1 Behold, I  
will send my messenger,  
and he shall prepare the  
way before me...**

**Matthew 3:1 In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,  
3 For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness...**

**Matthew 3:7** But when he saw many of **the Pharisees and Sadducees** come to his baptism, he said unto them, **O generation of vipers**, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

**Luke 7:29** And all the people that heard him, and the publicans, justified God, being baptized with the baptism of John.

**30** But **the Pharisees and lawyers** rejected the counsel of God against **themselves**, being not baptized of him.

at the last, when thy flesh and

12 And say, How have I hated  
instruction, and my heart  
despised reproof;**

Proverbs 15:31 The ear that  
heareth the reproof of life abideth  
among **the wise**.

32 He that refuseth instruction  
despiseth his own soul: but **he that  
heareth reproof getteth  
understanding**.

**Proverbs 29:15 The rod  
and reproof give wisdom:  
but a child left to himself  
bringeth his mother to  
shame.**

**Proverbs 15:10 Correction  
is grievous unto him that  
forsaketh the way: and he  
that hateth reproof shall  
die.**

**Psalm 25:9 The meek will  
be guide in judgment: and  
the meek will he teach his  
way.**

Jeremiah 19:15...they

Mark 8:17...perceive ye  
not yet, neither  
understand? **have ye your  
heart yet hardened?**

Acts 19:9 But when  
divers were **hardened,**  
and **believed not...**
