- I. Reasons for Charismania
  - A. Facebook Envy
    - 1. Testimonies of deliverance
    - 2. Exaltation of those with experiences
  - B. Impatience with God's Design
    - 1. Maturity takes time
    - 2. Maturation involves a lot of failure
  - C. False Teaching 2 Tim 4:3-4
    - 1. Somehow you are not complete w/o the experience
    - 2. Teaching one to do what the Spirit has supposedly enabled them through gifting
  - D. Emotional Experiences
    - 1. Hypnotism see III.
    - 2. Reinforced praise
- II. Biblical Theology
  - A. Spirit Baptism
    - 1. *baptizo* to immerse, submerge; to make whelmed (fully wet); used only (in the New Testament) of ceremonial ablution, (technically) of the ordinance of Christian baptism, baptize, wash.
    - 2. From Jesus Mk 1:8; Ac 1:5
    - 3. The placing of a believer into the body of Christ by the Spirit 1Co 12:13; Ga 3:27 a. The putting on of the new man, Christ – Ga 3:27
      - b. The positional crucifixion and resurrection of the believer Ro 6:3-9; Col 2:12; 1 Pe 3:21
  - B. Spiritual Gifts Ro 12:6-8; 1 Co 12-14; 1 Pe 4:10-11
    - 1. *pneumatikos* non-carnal, (humanly) ethereal (as opposed to gross), or (daemoniacally) a spirit, or supernatural, regenerate, religious, spiritual.
      - a. Used of Spiritual Gifts Ro 1:11; 1 Co 12:1; 14:1 (14:12 pneuma)
      - b. Used of Spiritually mature people 1 Co 2:15; 3:1; 14:37; Ga 6:1
      - c. Used of Spiritually things Ro 7:14; 15:27; 1 Co 2:13; 9:11; 10:3-4; 1 Co 15:44,46
    - 2. Given by the Spirit 1 Co 12:4,8-11 according to His Purpose 1 Co 12:14-18
    - 3. Given for the purpose of edification of the body -1 Co 12:7; 14:12,26
  - C. Tongues
    - 1. *glossa* the tongue; by implication, a language (specially, one naturally unacquired), tongue.

    - i. Two or three at the most, One at a time -1 Co 14:27

  - d. Not to be forbidden 1 Co 14:39

  - a. Ignorance of gifts and body life 1 Co 12
    - i. Source 4, 7, 11, 13
    - ii. Purpose 7, 12
    - iii. Need for all 14-27
    - iv. Level of importance 8-10, 28-30
  - b. The correct use of Gifts 1 Co 13
  - c. Contrasting Edification /Misuse of tongues 1 Co 14
    - i. Tongues–2
      - Speaks mysteries to God 2
      - Self-edification 4
      - Makes uncertain sound/ people can't understand 6-20
    - ii. Prophecy
      - Edifies the Body 3
      - Greater than tongues w/o interpreter 5
- III. The Problems with Charismania Chapter 69; pg 309-313
  - A. Physical
    - 1. When the emotional experience is sought, the thinking side of the body is put in neutral opening the person to the power of suggestion
    - 2. Like any other habit, the more it is practiced the more it becomes second nature
  - B. Moral
    - 1. Lying
    - 2. Embellishment
    - 3. Lends itself to a lack of rationality
  - C. Spiritual

- 1. Error producing unscriptural unreality
- 2. Dependance on more emotional events for spirituality and salvation
