FEAST OF WEEKS PENTECOST</p> <p>(Shavuoth)</p> <p>Lev 15:21, Num 26:31</p>	<p>Late Spring, seven weeks after Passover – First wheat harvest</p>	<p>Thanksgiving to God for the first of the wheat harvests and</p> <p>According to Oral Tradition, the time of the giving of the Law at Sinai</p> <p>[2nd Pilgrimage Festival]</p>	<p>God's first harvest of those redeemed in Christ, both Jews and Gentiles and</p> <p>God's Law written on the hearts of the redeemed; Divine POWER to live the Christian life</p>	<p>"When the day of Pentecost had come,...and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit...and there were added that day about three thousand souls." FEAST OF TRUMPETS (Rosh Hashanah) Lev 23:23-25, Num 29:1-6</p>	<p>Early Autumn (1st of Tishri, seventh month)</p>	<p>A solemn assembly – trumpets (shofar) blown to prepare for the national Day of Atonement</p>	<p>Announcing the Return of Jesus Christ, Judge of the world – Call to repentance – Gathering of Elect [1 Cor. 15:51-52; 1 Thess. 4:13-18]</p>	<p>Jesus said, "and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." Mat 24:30b-31</p>	<p>SOBERNESS AND HOPE: 5. CHRIST COMING FOR AND WITH HIS SAINTS!</p>

DAY OF ATONEMENT (Yom Kippur) Lev 23:26-32, Lev 16:1-34, Num 29:7</p>	<p>Autumn (10th of Tishri)</p>	<p>A solemn assembly for repentance and forgiveness under the Law – repeated annually</p>	<p>Final Judgment Day Believers in Jesus ALREADY forgiven by one atonement for all time Hebrews 9:11-13</p>	<p>"...the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom..." 1 Tim 4:1b-2 "So Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many..." Heb 9:28 "...and He is the atonement for our sins..." 1 John 2:2</p>	<p>6. CHRIST'S ATONEMENT FULLY EXPERIENCED— Already delivered from the penalty and power of sin... We will also be delivered from the presence and possibility of sin!</p>

FEAST OF TABERNACLES (Sukkot) Lev 23:33-34; 39-43</p>	<p>Autumn (15th of Tishri)</p>	<p>Harvest celebration and memorial of tabernacles in the wilderness [3rd Pilgrimage Festival]</p>	<p>Joyous assembly – all THE REDEEMED RULING and reigning with JESUS; LORD OF LORDS... and yet ever the LAMB</p>	<p>"Behold the tabernacle of God is among men, and He shall dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself shall be among them..."
