## A Kingdom that Cannot Be Shaken

Hebrews 12:18-29

## I. MT. SINAI (18-21; Ex 19:16-19; 20:18-21)—The Old Covenant: God's Terrifying Holiness

- A. <u>Earthly Senses</u> ()—something [a mountain] that can be touched
- **B.** <u>Terrifying Conditions</u> ()—fire, darkness, gloom and storm; *inhospitable*
- C. <u>Condemning Law</u>—God's deadly holiness
  - 1. Trumpet Blast and/or Loud Voice (Ex 19:18-19)
  - 2. Unbearable Commands (Gal 2:16)
- **D.** Moses the Mediator (Deut 5:23-27 & 9:19)—kept the people away

## II. MT. ZION (22-25)—The New Covenant: God's Gracious Fellowship

- A. <u>Heavenly Jerusalem</u> (Heb 11:10, 16)—spiritual home of God's people
  - 1. Not of This World—perceived by faith.
  - 2. The City Built by God—The City that Abraham was looking for
- B. <u>Joyful Assembly</u> ()—festal celebration; fellowship
  - 1. Innumerable Angels (Lk 15:7, 10)
  - 2. Fellow Believers (Lk 10:20; Phil 4:3)—living on earth now,
  - 3. <u>Sovereign God</u> ()—the *same holy God* who was at Mt. Sinai
  - **4.** <u>Glorified Saints</u> (Heb 11)—OT and NT believers who have already completed their race,
- C. <u>Saving Grace</u>—redeemed from the penalty of the law by the blood of Jesus
- **D.** <u>Jesus the Mediator</u> (24-25)—better mediator, better sacrifice, better covenant

- **III. THE GREAT SHAKING** (**26-27**; Hag 2:6-9, 21; )
  - **A.** God is the One doing the shaking. He is in control.
  - **B.** He is shaking the heavens and earth to bring about good. (Rom 8:28; Act 16:26)
    - 1. To Remove what can be shaken (Heb 8:5 & 9:8-10)
    - 2. To Establish what is eternal
      - a. To reveal what is solid/not solid
      - b. To <u>purify</u> the church
      - c. To evangelize the nations
    - **3. To bring in the Messianic Kingdom** (Dan 2:44; Rev 11:15; 2 Pet 3:10-13)— New Heavens and New Earth
  - C. We can have Peace while the earth is shaking.
    - 1. **God is our Refuge**. (Ps 16:8-9 & 62:2; Lk 6:47-48)
    - 2. Jesus is Returning. (Mat 24; Lk 21:25-28)—Look up!
- IV. THE PROPER RESPONSE (25, 28-29)
  - A. <u>Do Not Refuse Him</u> (25)—you must respond, your only hope
  - B. Be Thankful (28a)—
  - C. Offer Acceptable Worship (28b-29)
    - **1. With Reverence and Awe** (Lk 1:68, 74-75; Rom 12:1; Tit 2:11-12; Heb 12:14)—fear God and serve Him in holiness
    - **2. For our God is a** <u>Consuming Fire</u> (Num 11:1 & 16:35; Deut 4:24; 2 Kin 1:10, 12)—He is HOLY.
