II. BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES OF CHURCH GOVERNMENT

- A. CHRIST IS THE ONLY INDIVIDUAL WHO RULES OVER ALL HIS CHURCH ("the only King and Head of the church"; Eph.1:20-23; 5:23; Col.1:18; see Mt.16:18 with Eph.2:20)
- B. ONLY TWO PERMANENT OFFICES: ELDER & DEACON (Phil.1:1; 1Tm.3:1f,8f /1C12:28f; Eph4:11)
 - 1. A/apostle: eyewitness of resurrection (1Cor.12:28; 15:7,3-9; Acts 1:22; note: 1Cor.15:8, last of all)
 - 2. Prophet: new revelation (1Cor.12:28; 14:1f;26,29,30; see Jer.1:1f; see Eph.2:20; Heb.2:1f; Jude 3; 1Cor.3:10f)
 - 3. Evangelist: first wave (Eph.4:11 with Acts 21:8; 8:26f,40; 2Tm.4:5; see 1Cor.12:28 w/Eph.4:11)
 - 4. Teacher (1Cor.12:28; Eph.4:11; 1Tm.5:17; 4:12f)
 - 5. Elder (person; Ex.3:16,etc.; see Dt.1:9f; Phil.1:1; 1Tm.3:1f; 5:17; Tt.1:5; 1Pt.5:1,2f)
 - 6. Overseer (work; Tt.1:5f,7marg; Acts 20:17,28marg; see 1Pt.5:1,2f; Prov.27:23)
 - 7. Deacon (Phil.1:1; 1Tm.3:8f,11; see Acts 6:1-6)
- C. A PLURALITY OF ELDERS IN EACH CONGREGATION ("session", Ps.107:32; Acts 2:33f; see Acts 14:23; 20:17; Phil.1:1; Tt.1:5; see 1Pt.5:1; also *plurality* of Deacons, Acts 6:3; Phil.1:1)
- D. THREE WITNESSES: INWARD CALL & POPULAR ELECTION & OFFICIAL ORDINATION (1Tm.3:1f & Acts 1:23; 14:23 w/6:3f; Dt.1:9f & Dt.34:9; Acts 6:6; 13:2f; 1Tm.4:14; 5:22; see Dt.19:15; Mt.18:16)
- **E. ELDERS HAVE AUTHORITY TO** *RULE* (Heb.13:7,17,24; 1Th.5:12f; 1Pt.5:1-5 w/Eph.5:22f (see *LC,SC* on 5th commandment); e.g., Acts 15:4f; 19f; 30,31; also Mt.18:17f; Num.15:32-36)
- **F.** *PRIVILEGE TO SEEK HELP FROM* **THE BROADER BODY OF ELDERS** (presbytery, synod: "the courts of the church"; 1Tm.4:14; see Lk.22:66; Acts 22:5; see Acts 15:2f; Dt.17:8f; see Mt.18:17f)
- G. AUTHORITYOF THIS BROADER BODY TO RULE (see Acts 15:28f; including visit, see 30f,36f; vs. OEA)

III. SURVEY & CONTRAST OF HISTORICAL EXAMPLES OF CHURCH GOVERNMENT

- (note: exceptions and inconsistencies)
 - A. EPISCOPALIAN (*none* of the above principles; higher *offices* and *individuals* vs. higher *courts* and *plurality* of officers; i.e., CATHOLIC; ORTHODOX; ANGLICAN, EPISCOPAL, METHODIST)
 - B. CONGREGATIONAL (not II.E; congregation rules with Elders consent; i.e., CONGREGATIONAL, BAPTIST)
 - C. INDEPENDENT (not II.F,G; local government only; i.e., BAPTIST; yet "associations"; see "dedications")
 - **D. PRESBYTERIAN** (*II.A-G*; *plurality* of Elders and hierarchy of *courts vs.* EPISCOPAL; *Elders* rule *vs.* CONGREGATIONAL; *Courts* rule *also vs.* INDEPENDENT)

IV. THANK GOD FOR A CHURCH WITH FULL BIBLICAL GOVERNMENT!

- A. KNOW THAT YOU ARE LOVED AND CARED FOR! (Eph.4:11,12; 1Cor.12:28; 1Pt.5:4,1f; see Heb.13:17,20; 1Th.5:12f; 1f,11; Acts 20:17,28f; see 2Cor.4:15; 11:28f; Gal.4:19; Jer.23:2f; Ezk.34:16)
- **B. REMEMBER THAT YOU HAVE A PLACE TO GO FOR HELP!** (Mt.18:17; 1Cor.6:1-7; Deut.17:8f; see Acts 15:2f; Prov.11:14; 15:2; 24:6)
- C. CONTINUE TO HONOR GOD BY SUBMITTING YOURSELVES TO YOUR ELDERS IN THE TEACHING, PREACHING, SACRAMENTS, DISCIPLINE AND GOOD ORDER IN THE CONGREGATION! (Heb.13:17,20; 1Th.5:12f; 1Cor.16:16; 1Pt.5:5,1f; 1Cor.14:40; see Dt.17:12f)
- D. MAKE YOUR NEEDS & DESIRES KNOWN TO YOUR ELDERS. WE LOVE YOU AND ENDEAVOR TO USE OUR AUTHORITY TO BLESS YOU! (Heb.13:17; 1Th.5:12f; 1:7f,11; 1Pt.5:1f w/Eph.5:22f)
- *E. GIVE THANKS TO GOD FOR THE RICH BIBLICAL HERITAGE HE HAS GIVEN US AS A* **PRESBYTERIAN** *CHURCH!* (Heb.13:7,17; see 2Tm.3:14-17)
- F. CONTINUE PRAYERFULLY TO STUDY THE SCRIPTURES SO THAT YOU WILL GROW IN YOUR UNDERSTANDING, APPRECIATION & BENEFITTING FROM YOUR PRIVILEGE OF PARTICIPATING IN A PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH! (2Tm.3:14f /Phil.3:12-16; Eph.4:11-16; 2Pt.3:14f)
