## Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others:

1. What stood out to you in this sermon?
2. What is grace?
3. Give an example from your life that shows you need God's grace.
4. Why wouldn't Moses enter the Promised Land with the rest of Israel?
5. Why would Israel succeed in taking possession of the Promised Land?
6. Why were the priests to read the law of the Lord to the nation?
7. What is a witness?
8. What witnesses did the Lord provide against His rebellious people?
9. How does this passage show the grace of God?

### *Going Deeper:*

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

1. Do you recognize something of the depth of your need for God's grace? Explain.
2. How would the Song of Moses be a witness against Israel?
3. What made Israel undeserving of the Lord's blessing?
4. Why did the Lord bless Israel?
5. If you were in God's position, do you think you would have been gracious to Israel? Explain.
6. Is grace something God gives, or something that is part of His character, or both? Explain.
7. Are you in awe of God's grace? Explain.
8. How should you apply this sermon this week?
