## Paul's Prayer For You

#1. Truth to know: By God's grace when \_\_\_\_\_ walk by means of the Spirit, \_\_\_\_\_ are strengthened and \_\_\_\_\_ inner man is enabled by grace, through the power of the Spirit, to walk according to God's plan for \_\_\_\_\_.

#2. What is prayer?

Prayer is a means of \_\_\_\_\_ our sins. (1 John 1:9)

Prayer is a way to \_\_\_\_\_ Him. (Ephesians 5:20)

#3. Bowing/ bending the knees in prayer \_\_\_\_\_ an attitude of submission and in scripture it signified an especially fervent prayer. It suggests intimate, one on one, face to face communication with the Father.

#4. The word "**that**" is translated from the Greek word "**hina**" It states a purpose in the Greek and could be translated, "\_\_\_\_\_"

#5. When we think of God's glory, it is the summation of all of God's \_\_\_\_\_. His sovereignty, His omnipotence, His omnipresent, His omniscient, His holiness, His love, His eternity, His grace, etc.,

Verse 16 could be translated "in order that He would give you according to the riches of all of His unlimited \_\_\_\_\_."

#6. Ephesians 6:12 we have a \_\_\_\_\_ foe.

#7. Galatians 5:17 we have an \_\_\_\_\_ foe.

#8. I John 2:16 we have an \_\_\_\_\_ foe.

#9. The "lust of the flesh" (sensuality) is a craving for anything that \_\_\_\_\_ the senses.

#10. The "lust of the eyes" (materialism) is a covetous desire to own what we \_\_\_\_\_.

#11. The "pride of life" (egotism) is the desire to inflate our \_\_\_\_\_ reputation.

#12 "to be strengthened" is a verb in the Greek that means to \_\_\_\_\_ strong, to \_\_\_\_\_ strong.

It is in the passive voice meaning; God is the One who does this work in strengthening us, and it is by His \_\_\_\_\_ not ours that He does it \_\_\_\_\_ the Holy Spirit.

#13. In verse 17, **rooted and grounded** are in the perfect tense is a completed \_\_\_\_\_ in the past with continuing results, passive voice means God rooted and grounded you \_\_\_\_\_ the moment you put your faith in Christ for salvation.

#14 When we think about the love of Christ it is so \_\_\_\_\_ it isn't possible for us to fully comprehend. Paul's prayer is that we know the love of Christ not merely academically or intellectually, but that it would be \_\_\_\_\_ to us, moment by moment of every day!

#15 that (hina clause "in order that") you might be filled up to all the fullness of God.

What does this mean?

It means that by God's grace Paul wants your life to \_\_\_\_\_ the character of God. God is infinite and we will never measure up completely to His infinite glory, but as we moment by moment every day by the grace of God \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ the result is spiritual growth and fruit.
