## Truth: Wisdom's Compass

Proverbs on Truth, Honesty, and Justice

Wisdom is an attentiveness to God's Word, God's character, and God's created order in order to live life knowledgably and well as God intended it to be lived.

There are six things that the Lord hates, seven that are an abomination to him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent

- 6:16–19 blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that make haste to run to evil, a false witness who breathes out lies, and one who sows discord among brothers.
  - 11:1 A false balance is an abomination to the LORD, but a just weight is his delight.

Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue is but for a moment. Deceit is in the heart of those who devise evil, but those who plan

- 12:19–22 peace have joy. No ill befalls the righteous, but the wicked are filled with trouble. Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, but those who act faithfully are his delight.
  - 14:25 A truthful witness saves lives, but one who breathes out lies is deceitful.
  - 16:11 A just balance and scales are the LORD's; all the weights in the bag are his work.
  - 16:28 A dishonest man spreads strife, and a whisperer separates close friends.
  - 24:23b Partiality in judging is not good.

Like a madman who throws firebrands, arrows, and death is the man

- 26:18–20 who deceives his neighbor and says, "I am only joking!" For lack of wood the fire goes out, and where there is no whisperer, quarreling ceases.
  - 26:28 A lying tongue hates its victims, and a flattering mouth works ruin.

Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge

30:5–6 in him. Do not add to his words, lest he rebuke you and you be found a liar.
