"The Pilgrims Progress" Blessed Assurance (Page 23-25)

Introduction:

- 1. The Last Time:
 - We Were In "The Pilgrims Progress" Our Pilgrim:
 - Had Just Scaled The Great:
 - "Hill Of Difficulty!"
 - And If You Remember:
 - When Christian Was:
 - At The *Bottom* Of The Hill:
 - He *Prepared* For The Climb:
 - By Drinking From The Stream:
 - That Flowed At The Foot Of The Hill!
 - And Then As Christian Was:
 - Ascending The Hill He Started To Slow Down!
 - From A Run:
 - It Went To A Walk!
 - From A Walk:
 - It Turned To A Crawl!
 - But He Kept Plodding On:
 - Until The Lord Provided Him A Place Of Rest & Refreshment:
 - In The Cool Shade An Arbor:
 - About Half-Way Up!
- 2. But What Happened In That Arbor?
 - Christian Fell Asleep!
 - He Made It Half-Way Up The Hill!
 - But Then He Became Slothful!
 - And Only Got Back Up:
 - When He Was Stirred Up By A Message From The Lord:
 - Proverbs 6:6 "Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise!"
 - And With That:
 - He Was Off Like A Dart!
 - But He Lost Something:
 - Very Special In That Arbor:
 - And, As We Will See Tonight:
 - It Cost Him Very Dearly!
- 3. So As We Continue Our Journey With Christian:
 - At The Top Of The Hill:
 - On Page 23:
 - He Meets Two New Characters In Our Story:
 - With The Names:
 - Timorous & Mistrust!
 - "Timorous" Means:
 - Weak, Timid, And Apprehensive:
 - And Reflects A *Physical* Fear:
 - Of Difficulty & Danger!
 - As We Will See Timorous Doubted:
 - The *Protection* Of The King:
 - In The Face Of Danger!
 - "Mistrust" Means:
 - Wary, Doubtful And Suspicious:
 - And Reflects A *Mental* Fear:
 - Of Being Let Down!
 - And So Mistrust Doubted:
 - The *Power* Of The King:
 - In The Face Of Danger!

- And So Starting In Paragraph 4 We Read:
 - "Now, When He Was Got Up To The Top Of The Hill, There Came Two Men Running To Meet Him Amain!"
 - Read Until End Of Page 25, Paragraph 1:
 - "But While He Was Thus Bewailing His Unhappy Miscarriage, He Lift Up His Eyes, And Behold There Was A Very Stately Palace Before Him, The Name Of Which Was Beautiful; And It Stood Just By The Highway Side!"
- 4. This Entire Episode:
 - On Christian's Pilgrimage:
 - Has To Do With The Loss:
 - Of That Roll:
 - That Was Given To Him:
 - By One Of The Three "Shining Ones" Whom He Met:
 - At The Place Of His Deliverance Where He Saw The Cross & The Tomb!
 - But Was So Special About That Roll?
 - In Our Reading For Tonight:
 - Bunyan Tells Us What That Roll Was!
 - P.24/P.3 "This Roll Was The Assurance Of His Life And Acceptance At The Desired Haven!"
- 5. Christian's Roll:
 - Was The Symbol Of His Assurance!
 - Assurance That He Was, In Fact, A Christian!
 - Assurance That He Had Eternal Life And:
 - Assurance That He Had A Home In Heaven:
 - The Celestial City!"
 - Assurance:
 - Is A Very Special Gift:
 - From God To Those Who Belong To Him:
 - Because They Believe In:
 - The Lord Jesus Christ As Their Savior From Sin!
- 6. The Bible Teaches Us That:
 - As A Christian, You Can Have Assurance Of Your Salvation!
 - The Apostle John Even Tells Us:
 - That It Was For This Purpose:
 - He Wrote The Letter Of 1 John!
 - 1 John 5:12-13 "He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. / These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may *know* that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God!"
 - This Kind Of Assurance From God:
 - Is A Gift & Is Very Encouraging & Reassuring:
 - When You Are Faced With:
 - A Hill Of Difficulty:
 - Or A Hill Of Danger Or Despair!

- 7. But This Gift:
 - Is Also A Very Fragile Gift!
 - **IE:** Its Like A Gift You Might Get At Christmas Wrapped Up In A Box That Says "Fragile Handle With Care!" Only You Didn't See Those Words Until After You Shook It! And When You Open It Its Broken!
 - God's Gift Of Assurance:
 - Can Quickly & Easily Get Broken Or:
 - Even Go Missing:
 - When It Is Shaken Up By:
 - Sin!
 - This Is What Happened To Christian:
 - In That Arbor!
 - His Sin Of Spiritual Slothfulness:
 - Caused The Roll Of His Assurance:

- To Tumble To The Ground!
 - So That When He Was Stirred Up By God's Word:
 - He Left It Behind In The Arbor!
- 8. Now For A Time:
 - It Didn't Seem Like Christian Needed That Roll!
 - Because When He Got To The Top Of The Hill:
 - It Seemed Like:
 - He Got A Second Wind!
 - Especially When He Met Timorous & Mistrust:
 - Going The Opposite Way:
 - Because Of Another Danger In The Path:
 - Those Two Lions!
- * But Christian Made:
- 1. A Fresh Resolution!
 - A Fresh Resolution To:
 - Not Turn Back!
 - He Remembered:
 - Where He Left!
 - The City Of Destruction!
 - He Remembered:
 - Where He Was Going!
 - The Celestial City! And:
 - He Remembered:
 - All That He Already Went Through:
 - To Get Where He Was!
 - So He Made A Fresh Resolution:
 - I "Must Venture" He Said!
 - "I Will Yet Go Forward!"
 - Because He Believed The Dangers *Behind* Him Were Still Greater Than The Dangers *Ahead* Of Him!
 - So We See From This:
 - That Christian Still Had:
 - Some Spiritual Strength & Courage:
 - In Spite Of His Sin In The Arbor!
 - Christian Was Still:
 - A Christian!
 - And Even This Desire To "Go Forward" & Persevere:
 - Was A Gift From The Lord!
 - But What Timorous & Mistrust Told Him:
 - About Those Lions:
 - Made Him Afraid Once Again!
 - And It Was Then He Realized:
 - His Roll Was Missing & His Assurance Was Gone!
 - George Cheever:
 - "There Is Nothing [That] Takes Away The Courage [Of A Christian] As The Consciousness Of Guilt!"
 - Has This Happened To You?
 - Have You Lost Your Assurance Of Faith:
 - Because Of Some Sin In Your Life:
 - That You Are Harboring Or:
 - Have Not Brought To The Lord?
 - This Is Something Even:
 - King David Experienced:
 - When He Sinned Against The Lord:
 - In The Matter Of Uriah The Hittite & His Wife Bathsheba!
 - In Fact In Psalm 51 Our Psalm For Today:
 - We Find The Roll Of $\it David$'s Assurance Missing:

- When He Prays 51:11-12 "Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. / Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit!"
- David's Sin:
 - Brought Doubt Into His Mind:
 - Instead Of Assurance!
 - Doubt Of God's Presence With Him!
 - "Cast Me Not Away From Thy Presence!"

- David's Sin:
 - Brought Despair Into His Heart:
 - Instead Of Assurance!
 - Despair Of God's Power Being Removed From Him!
 - "Take Not Thy Holy Spirit From Me!"

- David's Sin:
 - Brought Discouragement Into His Soul:
 - Instead Of Assurance!
 - Discouragement Because The Peace Of His Salvation Was Gone!
 - "Restore Unto Me The Joy Of Thy Salvation!"
- Now This Does Not Mean That:
 - God's Presence & Power & Peace:
 - Had Left Him!
 - It Just Means That David's Experience And Assurance Of Those Blessings:
 - Was Missing!
- **IE:** It's A Bit Like That Man Who Bought Into Bitcoin When It First Started Out! Now It Is Worth Millions! But He Forgot The Password To His Account And Now He's Locked Out!
 - Just Like His Forgetfulness Locked Him Out Of Enjoying The Benefits Of His Investment:
 - Sin Will Lock You Out Of:
 - Your Enjoyment Of The Benefits Of Salvation!
- The Loss Of Assurance Because Of Sin:
 - Will Often Be Reflected In:
 - A Lack Of Peace In Your Heart!
 - A Lack Of Pleasure In Your Salvation!
 - 51:12 "Restore Unto Me The Joy Of Thy Salvation!"
 - A Lack Of Progress In Your Walk!
 - A Lack Of Praise On Your Lips!
 - A Lack Of Prayer!
- Now This Does Not Mean That:
 - All Doubt & Despair & Discouragement:
 - Is Caused By Sin!
 - Even John Bunyan Experienced A Lack Of Assurance:
 - About The Time When He Was Arrested:
 - And Put Into Prison For Preaching The Gospel Without A License!
 - George Cheever:
 - "There Was Great Gloom Upon His Soul, And The Things Of God Hidden From Him, And Neither Sun Nor Stars Appeared For Many Days!"
- So Even Though Not All:
 - All Doubt & Despair & Discouragement:
 - Is Caused By Sin!
 - Many Times It Is!
 - And We Need To Regularly Examine Ourselves:
 - And Keep This Prayer Continually Before The Lord:
 - Psalm 139:23-24 "Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: / And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!"
- This Is What Christian Experienced!
 - And What He Needed Most Was:

2. A Fresh Relief!

- A Fresh Relief:

- From The Burden Of His Sin!
 - All Throughout His Trek Back To:
 - The Arbor On The Hill Of Difficulty:
 - Christian:
 - Sighed & Wept & Chided Himself:
 - For Being So Foolish!

- He Had Failed To:
 - "Watch And Be Sober!"
 - As The Lord Tells Us In:
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:6-8!
 - "Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober. / For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night. / But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation!"
- The Grief Of Christian For His Sin:
 - Is Almost Too Hard For Us To Read!
 - Because Sentence After Sentence & Even Paragraph After Paragraph:
 - He Bemoans & Bewails his "Sinful Sleep!" Its Gloomy!
- But This Was Exactly Where Christian Needed To Be:
 - In Order For Him To Find:
 - His Roll Of Assurance Once Again:
 - And Find Relief For His Burden:
 - From The Lord!
- Relief & Assurance:
 - Can Be Renewed:
 - Through Personal Repentance:
 - Of Sin & Sinfulness:
 - In Your Heart & Life!
- Ken Puls "Repentance is The Way To Joy And Light And Renewed Hope Of Forgiveness And Life!"
 - And This Kind Of:
- Repentance Includes A Remembrance:
 - Of Your Sin Against The Lord!
 - This Doesn't Mean That:
 - You Relive Your Sin But That:
 - You Remember What Your Sin Was & What Your Sin Does!
 - This Means That You:
 - Take Responsibility For Your Sin!
 - You Don't Make Excuses For It:
 - You Admit To It & Realize "The Exceeding Sinfulness" Of Your Sin!
 - David Remembers *His* Sin:
 - In Psalm 51:3 "For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me!"
 - To Find Your Roll Of Assurance Again:
 - You Need To Remember & Admit & Acknowledge:
 - Your Sin Against God! But Also:
- Repentance Includes A Regret!
 - Christian Expresses His Regret:
 - When He Realized Just How Much:
 - Time & Effort He Wasted:
 - In Having To Return To The Arbor On The Hill!
 - He Said To Himself:
 - "How Many Steps Have I Taken In Vain!"
 - Instead Of Going Over The Path Of Difficulty Just Once:
 - Now He Went Over It Three Times!
 - David Too Expressed Regret For His Sin:
 - In Psalm 51:4 "Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest!"
 - To Find Your Roll Of Assurance Again:
 - You Need To Not Only:
 - Express Regret & Sorrow For Your Sin:

- You Need To Feel It In Hour Heart!
- Because As Paul Wrote:
 - In 2 Corinthians 7:10 "For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death!"
 - The Sorrow & Regret Of The World:
 - Means That You Are Sorry:
 - That You Got Caught!
 - The Sorrow & Regret Of The Lord:
 - Means That You Are Sorry:
 - For The Sin!
- But Even Though Christian:
 - Felt Regret For:
 - Wasting So Much Time & Effort:
 - Was It Really In Vain?
 - "Thus The Experience Was Not Really In Vain, For Every Step Backward In Self-Examination Is In Reality A Forward Step!" (John Kelman)
- Repentance Includes A Request!
 - An Appeal To The Lord & His Grace:
 - For A Fresh, Though Undeserved:
 - Relief!
 - The First Thing Christian Did:
 - When He Realized He Lost His Roll:
 - Because Of His Sin On The Hill Of Difficulty:
 - He Fell "Upon His Knees" & "He Asked God Forgiveness For That His Foolish Act!"
 - And This Is What David Did:
 - All Throughout Psalm 51!
 - It's Prayer & A Plea!
 - He Prays For God's Cleansing & Forgiveness!
 - 51:9-10 "Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. / Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me!"

Conclusion:

- 1. After Christian Repented Of His Sin:
 - By Remembering It & Regretting It & Requesting For It:
 - To Be Forgiven By The Lord:
 - He Was Given Fresh Relief & Assurance:
 - When The Lord Opened His Eyes:
 - Back In The Arbor:
 - To Find His Roll Of Assurance!

- Bunyan Tells Us That:
 - He Rejoiced & Gave Things:
 - And With "Joy And Tears" "Betook Himself Again To His Journey!"
- 2. We Can Be Sure That:
 - This Happened To David As Well!
 - We Can Be Sure That The Lord Answered His Prayer:
 - And Restored Unto Him The Joy Of His Salvation!
 - In Psalm 30:4-5 David Also Wrote:
 - "Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. / For his anger [endureth but] a moment; in his favour [is] life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy [cometh] in the morning!"
- 3. But Even Though:
 - For Christian & For David:
 - Their Roll Of Assurance Was Restored To Them:
 - They Both Still Experienced Some Consequences For Their Sins!
 - In Our Story:
 - Christian Still Had To Walk In The Dark:
 - When The "Sun Went Down!"

- And It Caused Him To Remember:
 - The "Vanity Of His Sleeping" Even More!
- So Even Though Your Sin:
 - May Be Forgiven:
 - It Is Still Hard:
 - To Forget!
- And Even Though You May Be Ready:
 - For The Dangers That Lie Ahead:
 - Like Those Lions:
 - You May Still Feel Regret:
 - For The Sins Of Your Past!

- 4. But Remember!
 - When You Repent Of Your Sin:
 - The Acts Of Remembrance & Regret:
 - Will Not Bring Relief:
 - By Themselves!
 - Relief & Assurance:
 - Will Only Come:
 - When You Look Again & Afresh:
 - To Your Savior!
 - The One Who Paid The Price:
 - For The Very Sin:
 - That Caused You To Doubt!
- 5. And What Does The Lord Provide Next?
 - As We Will See Next Week:
 - God Provides A Place Of "Relief And Security For Pilgrims!"
 - A Place That Is Right In The Middle Of:
 - The Darkness & The Dangers:
 - Of The Night!"
 - God Leads His People To:
 - His "Palace Beautiful!"
